Conditions of entry: Entry is based on acceptance of the full list of [Conditions of Entry](#) which is available for viewing on our website, caboolturedressage.org.au The onus is on the competitor to be aware of the rules that apply to the CDG Grounds and events.

- Riders must be a full Competitive Member of Equestrian Australia
- Riders must fulfill the Amateur Owner Rider criteria to enter this event. Only AOR riders riding horses will be accepted. Riders must be 21 or over.
- Competitions will be limited to 30 riders and competitions will not be split.
- Riders must qualify to enter with a minimum of 1 qualifying percentage of at least 60% at the level which they intend to compete. Qualifying score to have been gained within the previous 12 months of the closing date of entries. Riders will be ranked according to the qualifying percentage & the top 30 riders will gain a position.
- Champion & reserve will be awarded at each level where combinations receive 60% or greater in each competition.
- Youth & Young Rider Division is for riders aged 10 years to 20 years. This is not a championship event for this age group just an opportunity for them to compete.
- This division will compete in the same competitions as the AOR riders but will be placed separately & award separate ribbons. Numbers will be limited & on a first in acceptance.
- Competitions are still limited to 30 combinations & the Youth & Young Riders will be accepted to fill any vacancies in the competitions. Those not accepted will get a full refund of entries.
