GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. NEDDs events are conducted in accordance with Equestrian Australia rules www.equestrian.org.au. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with the current rules and regulations.

BIOSECURITY & SAFETY

- 2. Horse health declaration forms must be completed & handed in at Gear Check at each event prior to riding.
- 3. Should the need for a Quarantine area be required, this will be situated in the round yard at the far back area of the grounds. All riders/grooms are required to follow directions from the organising committee should the need arise for quarantine.
- 4. It is the responsibility of all competitors and helpers to please report unsafe or hazardous situations to the Event organisers.

NOMINATIONS

- 5. All NEDDs event entries must be made through www.nominate.com.au. It is the sole responsibility of the competitor to ensure that entries are made before the close of entry deadline. The organisers reserve the right to alter the program.
- 6. NEDDs reserves the right to reject any entry where incomplete or incorrect information has been provided or the correct fees have not been paid.
- 7. For Official Competitive Classes Entrants must have EA Competitor membership & have full horse registration (including bridle number). Proof of membership and/or horse registration may be requested.
- 8. For Unofficial Participant/Club Classes Entrants must be current NEDD members or be an EA Competitor or Participant member. Horses do not need to be EA registered. Proof of membership may be requested.
- 9. Maximum of 3 classes per horse, over two consecutive levels. Maximum of 3 horses per rider.
- 10. Classes may be closed or split based on the number of entries received, in which case a reserve list will be kept.
- 11.In the event of cancellation of the competition, 20% of the nomination fee will be retained by the organising committee to cover administration costs.

PRIZES & PRESENTATION

- 12. Presentation of prizes & ribbons will be held at the finish of the all classes. Prizes, test sheets, ribbons & money will not be posted.
- 13.Official Competitive Classes Ribbons to 6th place, Prizes or Money for 1st 3rd. Prizes will be determined based on number of entries for the class.
- 14. Participant/Club Classes Ribbons to 6th place.

DRAW

- 15. The draw will be posted on the NEDD website www.noosaeumundidistrictdressage.com and www.nominate.com.au.
- 16.Please check on Facebook and NEDD website for revised draw details and wet weather updates/cancellation notifications.

 SCRATCHINGS
- 17. Please notify the organisers if you intend to withdraw from all or part of the competition.
- 18. For Scratching's prior to the day, please email: noosa.eumundi.dressage@gmail.com. For Scratching's on the day call or text 0408071653.
- 19. No refunds will be made after close of entries unless a veterinary/medical certificate is provided. Request for refunds must be supplied within five working days from the date of the competition by email:

ON THE DAY

- 20. Competitors are required to report to the Gear Check Steward before each class. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their equipment meets the EA requirements and safety regulations.
- 21. Riders have the choice or competing with or without a Jacket BUT you must wear a light coloured competition shirt with sleeves in Official Classes if riding Jacketless. Riders may ride in coloured shirts in Club & Participant Classes.
- 22. Bridle numbers must be clearly displayed on both sides of the horse for all Official Competitive Classes. Please note all Stallions must display EA Green Stallion Discs.
- 23. Riders are required to compete in the order stated on the draw. It may be possible to move up in the draw if you wish take the place of a scratching. Please confirm with the Gear Check Steward on the day if you wish to do this.
- 24.NEDD is a small club and we are dependent on assistance from each competitor with essential tasks, especially writing for judges and running sheets to the scorers. Please ensure you respond to requests for assistance when they are made over the public address otherwise classes may be held up.

YARDS & PARKING

- 25. There is ample parking around the grounds with good shade. Please be considerate to other competitors when positioning your vehicle/float and ensure all manure and rubbish are removed at the end of the day.
- 26.A limited number of yards are available and Committee/helpers will have first access to these yards please email noosa.eumundi.dressage@gmail.com for details. Feel free to set up your own yard at your float (must not be rope or electric).

ON THE GROUNDS

- 27. The round yard is the designated area to be used for lunging only. There is to be no lunging in the main warmup area.
- 28. NEDDs discourages dogs from attending events. If a dog must be in attendance, in the interests of safety the dog must be restrained at all times and kept away from the competition areas.
