

2019 Equestrian Queensland Sport Development Funding Program EQ High Performance Funding Program



Submission of the attached application form indicates acceptance of the program terms and conditions outlined below.

1. ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Equestrian Queensland High Performance Funding Program is for assisting the Eventing, Dressage and Jumping Sport Committees to run/fund their state based squad rider clinics.

2. TERMS & CONDITIONS

To be eligible for funding under this program your EQ Sport Committee must meet the following criteria:

- Be an Equestrian Queensland recognised EQ Sport Committee
- Use EA current and registered EA Coaches and Officials or Equestrian Australia Nationally recognized qualified professionals to deliver the clinics;
- All Squad riders are to receive a squad uniform
- EQ Funding for each clinic is to be paid to the SC at the conclusion of the clinics, upon receipt of the rider attendee list, timetable and copy of the overall budget (to include both income and expenditure lines).
- EQ to be included in all squad communication (cc'd)
- Squads are to be announced after EQ has received a copy of the riders Squad Agreements/contracts with a whole of sport 2018 Squad announcement to be scheduled for early December 2017.

2.1 How do I apply?

The following steps apply to **all** applications for funding:

- Ensure all coaches hold a current EA Coaching qualification and are qualified to deliver the clinic OR are recognised by a National Federation (and have insurance to coach within Australia)
- 2. Complete the application form and Acquittal documentation (supply evidence as attachments where necessary)

2.2 How much funding can my sports committee receive?

Funding is limited to a maximum of \$3000 per sport committee per year.

2.3 Important dates:

This funding is open Squad rider clinics conducted from 1 January to 1 December 2018. Activities conducted outside these dates will NOT be eligible for funding.

Please note: All follow-up paperwork and invoices are required to be submitted to EQ by 1 December 2019, failure to do so may result in any monies being forfeited.
