All Riders **MUST** be EA members or WHT members. Memberships with EA will be confirmed prior to the event. Restricted WHT membership for this weekend is available at \$5.

Opening Date: 21/03/2016
Closing Date: 11/04/2016 (unless classes are full earlier)
Start Time: 8.00 am
Venue: Morgan Park, Warwick, Queensland

Directions to WHT: Enter gate at Morgan Park. Do not turn off. Follow the bitumen road all the way to the end. When entering gate take left at fork, follow around arenas up around to the right to yards and camping.

All dogs must be kept on a leash. Please pick up after your dog.

STRICTLY NO dogs allowed on the cross country course during the duration of the competition. You may be asked to leave the grounds should you not respect these rules.

Electric fences and portable yards are NOT to be erected.

Camping: powered sites \$25 per night and unpowered \$15 per night.

Yard: \$20 per day.

Catering will be available from Saturday breakfast until late afternoon.

For Dressage and Combined Training nominations the following will apply:

1. No refunds after close of entries (16/04/2015).
2. Refunds prior to close of entries will attract a 10% administration fee.
3. If the event is cancelled, there will be a 20% administration fee withheld from nominations.

Classes are limited to 35 riders per class, once this number has been reached, a wait list will operate.

The same horse may only compete in 3 dressage tests on the same day, either to straight dressage and one combined training or 3 straight dressage tests. The same horse can only compete in 2 consecutive levels of dressage. The same horse can only compete in one combined training class. **Juniors** – Please state when entering if you are a junior rider.

Biosecurity Requirements

It is a biosecurity requirement to compete and hand in to the event organisers, upon arrival, a Horse Health Declaration form. Failure to present a **fully completed** Horse Health Declaration prior to starting may result in **Elimination** from the event. This can be downloaded from:

Combined Training show jumping will start with the 45 cm and will then go up in height. Riders will be required to listen for announcements as to which height is open.

Helpers Roster for Interschool Riders

It is a condition of entry that each rider must provide the name and contact details of a helper for each discipline they enter. The Helpers Roster will be available on Nominate prior to the event. Each helper is required to report to the Secretary's office on the grounds at least 15 minutes prior to their allotted starting time. **Helpers who fail to do their tasks will have their riders names forwarded to the State Interschool Committee.**

Saddlery & Equipment

A designated gear check point will be made available and is compulsory for all competitors to present themselves before competing. Interschool number displayed on **both** sides of the horse. For a full list of approved saddlery and equipment please refer to the current Interschool Handbook and EA Rules.

COME AND TRY CLASSES

These classes are to promote Equestrian Sports to junior who may have not completed in EQ/IQ competitions previously.

It also gives current members the opportunity to bring younger beginner competitors to the event, and give it a go!

Classes for the Come and Try include:

Dressage Classes 1 and 2;
Combined Training Class 11;
Beginner Ring.

T-SHIRT HACK DAY

Event is being held in the main arena. Competitors do not need to present to Gear Check. This is for the dressage/combined training competitors only.

Entry is by ticket system, available at the office for purchase. Must be completed prior to entering the ring for class. The office is the demountable building next to the Club House.

Approved riding helmets and boots must be worn in all classes. Riders to wear a collared shirt with sleeves. Plaiting optional.

Horse Health Declarations to be handed into office PRIOR to competing.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

No stallions permitted.

Judges decision is final. Any abuse towards judges will result in instance elimination and dismissal from the grounds.

Lead Line and beginner ring is not eligible for Supreme.

Maiden: Horses and ponies that have not won a first place at any open hack day or agricultural show in an open ring.

Novice: Horses and ponies that have not won a first place at any open hack day or agricultural show in an open ring.

Open classes are open to all horses and ponies.

Pleasure classes require all horses and ponies to be ridden in a snaffle with no whips or spurs.

Beginner classes are open to all riders who have not won a first place in any open competition.

Entry Fee: \$3 per class. Ribbons to 4th.

All riders in Classes 1-9 are to be under 16 years. All riders awarded a ribbon on the day. Riders are encouraged to compete in the spirit that this ring is intended. The Judge may move a horse/rider to another ring if deemed necessary.

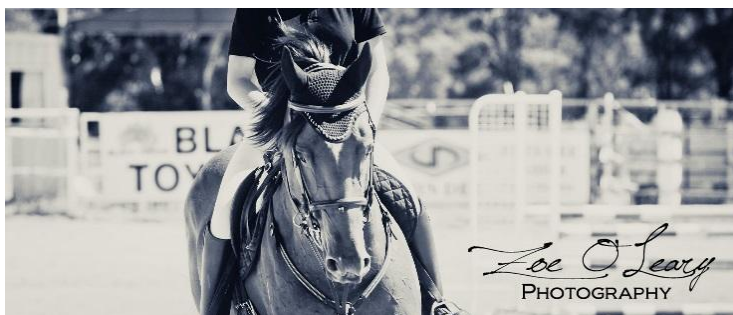
