**Application for upgrading to be accompanied by:**

- Copy of horse's current performance card or proof of performance as stated below.

**Application Fee:** Fee **\$50 inc GST** is payable on application.

**EFA Rule 1.14:** Any request for exception to the minimum point requirement to compete at Prix St Georges or above must be made to the State Dressage Authority (SDA). To be considered for exemption the horse must:

- *compete at least twice in Official Advanced competitions*
- *gain at **least 60% or higher\*** at **two separate events\****
- *there must be at least two judges one of whom must be an A level.*

On successful completion of the above, the SDA will allocate the horse 80 grading points

*\* Special Note:*

- a) The mark 60% or higher is an average of all the marks from each judge - the final score and*
- b) Two separate events indicate separate venues and separate dates i.e. One event can be Autumn Classic (April) and the other can be Brenda Whitman (July) even though both events are organised by the same club.*

**EFA Rule 1.19:** A horse may compete Hors Concours (HC) at any level below their grade and at only one level above.
