- Definitely NO late or phone nominations will be accepted.
- No refunds after the closing date unless accompanied by a vet or doctor's certificate.
- Stallions are permitted to compete provided they are ridden by persons of 18 years or over, and show EA stallion disc at all times.
- Each horse may only compete in a maximum of 3 tests at 2 consecutive levels.
- Each rider may only enter a maximum of 3 horses.
- Junior classes available to riders from the start of the year they turn 12 to end of the year they turn 18.
- Interschool Queensland (IQ) competitors are welcome. Please provide IQ number on entry form.
- Please send stamped self-addressed envelope for a copy of the draw if not on email.
- If you require sheets, ribbons etc. posted to you, please leave a SAE and stamp at the office on the day.
- Dogs must be restrained at all times.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the program at any time.
- A fully completed **Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration** must be handed prior to the competition commencing.
