

Queensland Winter Shows Points Score Series

Four of the QId Winter Series Shows are running a point score competition for the best performed horse and rider combination who compete at all four Shows in the Grand Prix and World cup classes.

The best performed Horse and Rider combination over the 4 classes will receive \$1500, and Runner Up will receive \$500

Eligibility for the Series:

Horse and rider combination must start in all 4 classes stated below

- Sunshine Coast Show jumping Club July Show Grand Prix
- Glen Haven Park Grand Prix
- Gatton World Cup
- Caboolture World Cup

Points to be allocated to the top 10 Horse and Rider combinations as per below
