RING EVENTS

Steward: Mr Gerald Pedler CONDITIONS below apply to rings 1, 2, & 3.

- 1. The Ring Committee reserves the right to change or abandon the Programme.
- 2. **Nomination Fee: \$3 per event unless otherwise stated**. All entries, ticket system whereby competitors purchase a 'Ticket' at the Secretary's Office on the days of the Show. One ticket per class and acceptance in that class is by presentation of ticket. TICKET refundable if not damaged.
- 3. All entries must be in the name of the owner of the horse.
- 4. Ribbons awarded to placegetters in horse events. 1st Blue, 2nd Red, 3rd Yellow, 4th Green, 5th Brown.
- 5. A marshalling yard will be provided. *PLEASE NOTE * Competitors hold themselves liable for disqualification if not in attendance when their class is called to enter the ring for Judging.
- 6. A Rider 12 years and over competing in Ring 1 can compete in the Rider Class in Ring 2 on the same horse. This is the only class a junior rider with the same horse (who has been competing in ring 1 at this Show) can compete in Ring 2. The Rider may compete on another horse in Ring 2 but neither ring will be held up for any competitor competing in both rings.
- 7. Protests must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within one (1) hour of the award being given, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which may be retained by the Society if the protest is, in the opinion of the Executive, frivolous. The decision in this respect will be final and conclusive.
- 8. Do not enter horses in events being run simultaneously in Rings 1,2, 3.
- 9. Lady and Gentleman rider means: Seventeen (17) years and over, on the first day of the Show.
- 10. In rings1 &, 2 a junior is deemed a rider thirteen years of age and under. A junior rider upon reaching fourteen years may elect to ride in Senior Events; however, a junior may not compete in both Senior and Junior Events on the same horse at the Show with the exception of Rule 6.
- 11. All horses to be measured must be in attendance at the marshalling yard at 8am on the day of competition. Measuring cards from preceding (12months) will be accepted.
- 12. Height Classes Pony classes not to exceed 14hh i.e. ponies 14hh must compete in the pony classes.

Riding Ponies & Saddle Ponies not to exceed 14.2hh (ponies 14.2hh can compete in these classes) Galloway classes - over 14hh and not exceeding 15hh.

Hack Classes - Over 15hh.

If insufficient numbers, at the judge's discretion, horses will be classified into weight and/or gender classes immediately prior to the event.

When measuring a horse, galloway or pony, an allowance of 9.5 mm (3/8in.) is to be made for shoes

- 13. **Helmets to be used by any rider under 17 years**. This includes costume classes, child's quietest pony and the ridden stock horse classes. ASA Standard approved helmets to be worn in all JUMPING EVENTS.
- 14. A horse must compete in its class. The Committee reserves the right to add classes to the programme just prior to the Show as they deem necessary to cater for unexpected interest in particular breed classes.
- 15. **Any Other Breed Class**: Open to horses who are registered and financial members of the respective Society, and who have not competed in any other breed class.
- 16. **Supreme Champions** includes Champions from both Ring 1 & 2.
- 17. An Entire horse (stallion) is barred from Hack events including dressage.
- 18. Maidens never won a first prize and must be such at time of commencement of event.
- 19. Novice never won a Championship.
- 20. Ponies may be led by an adult but ridden only by a child under 17 years of age except in Aust. Saddle Pony Classes.
- 21. All Colts & Stallions must be led with a bit and /or chain and bar and sturdy head stall.
- 22. Persons under the age of 17 years FORBIDDEN to handle Stallions in any event.
- 23. All led classes must produce papers on request by the steward
- 24. Show jumping will be conducted under E.F.A. Rules.

- 25. Riders must present Horse Grading Cards.
- 26. Prize money will be distributed by Steward at completion of each event.
- 27. No spurs with spikes will be permitted
- 28. ** NOTE COMPETITORS ** No cruelty will be tolerated to Horses, such as excessive use of Whip, Spurs, Jerking of Mouth. PENALTY BANNING FROM THE GROUNDS.
- 29. An Exhibit to which a Prohibited Substance has been administered is in breach of the By-Laws as per the Qld Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc. and must be removed from the Showgrounds upon demand by the Society.
- 30. Stalls must be paid for when booked and indemnity form signed before stalls can be allocated. A CAMPING FEE TICKET of \$10 to be purchased and shown to Secretary before 'RING TICKETS' can be purchased. These Fees go towards maintenance of Stalls and the financing of new ones. No refunds if stalls not taken.
- 31. All competitors ride or drive at their own risk and the Society will not accept responsibility for injuries to man or beast.
- 32. Electric Fences must not be across walkways. Any injury caused to person or animal from electric fence is the FENCE OWNER'S responsibility. Electric fences to be erected in allocated area.
- 33. Classes with more than 10 entries will be split according to the Judge's discretion.

CAPELLA SHOW JUNIOR AGGREGATE AWARD

FIRST: \$15. Riders for this event shall be 13 years and under 17 years. Points scored for this event shall be restricted to such events which are restricted to riders 13 years and under 17 years in rings 1 & 2 only. Points obtained by Junior Riders in Open events shall not be included in this aggregate. More than one horse may be nominated by the rider. Points accumulate for horse and rider combination only.
