

The need for a Dressage Qld clinic policy is necessary to remove potential bias when a limited number of lessons are available with an International Coach/Trainer, and oversubscription occurs at a Dressage Qld organized clinic.

The ideas behind the policy are to:

- a. Help the dissemination of information from coaches/coach educators/judge educators etc, downwards.
- b. Meet squad benefits criteria as per squad agreements.
- c. Reward the volunteers of our sport.

When oversubscription to a Dressage Qld organized clinic with an International Coach/Trainer occurs, preference will be allocated on a points system as per the Dressage Qld Clinic Policy Points Table (see below).

Where oversubscription occurs, second horses will be placed on the reserve list.

Cancellation policy: Money will not be refunded on cancellations made within 48 hours of the start of the clinic, regardless of the reason, unless another combination is found to fill the ride time/s. The cancelling rider must first check with the organiser to see if there is a reserve list. If a reserve list is unavailable, it is the responsibility of the cancelling rider to find a replacement, otherwise lesson fees are forfeit.
