Riding since the age of 6, I found out about RDA at Burpengary's Cartmill Centre in 1998 after suffering partial paralysis on my left side.

Since 2000 I have competed in the RDAQ State Championships, and have been Grade II State Champion for the past 8 years.

In 2001 I competed in my first RDAA National Championship at Werribee, Victoria, and have been part of the RDAQ State team since 2002.

I was invited to join the RDAA National Development Squad in 2006, and was part of the squad until it came under the Equine Australia (EA) banner.

I was also in the EA National Development Squad in 2009. In the inaugural FEI Para-Equestrian Championship /CPEDI 3* held at SIEC (2009) I placed as Grade II Reserve Champion.

Since 2004 I have been competing with the Caboolture Dressage Club at Preliminary level, as well as RDA and para-equestrian tests. I am currently training for Novice with "Ace of Diamonds".
