<u>Note:</u> There are no restrictions on which level of competition (novice or advanced) that competitors can enter, however it is recommended that competitors choose a level that is appropriate for the level of training and experience of the driver and their equine/s.

EVENT AND VENUE DETAILS

- **Dressage & 1* Combined Driving Championship Classes** To enter championship classes you must be a participant or competitor member of EA (horse registration is encouraged for championship classes). If you are not a member of EA, you are able to enter unofficial classes but not championships classes. Unofficial classes will follow the same format as championship classes.
 - o Competitors will drive a dressage test and a cones course.
 - Scores from the dressage phase will be used to determine the placings for the Dressage Championship.
 - Scores from the dressage and cones will be combined to determine the placings for the 1*
 Combined Driving Championship.
- **Dressage** Dressage arena will be 100m x 40m. A separate 100m x 40m warm up arena will also be available.

All Novice Classes: EA Novice 1

All Advanced Classes: FEI 1*B (former Test 1)

- Cones This will be conducted as a fault competition and all of the cones will be measured.
 Novice classes 40cm allowance, Advanced classes 30cm allowance. (Note: Horse team Novice 50cm allowance, Advanced 40cm allowance).
- Combined Marathon (unofficial) This will be conducted as a time competition and all of the cones will be measured. The combined marathon course will be available for inspection and to be walked from 7am on the day of the competition. The marathon obstacles are all purpose built.

- **Catering** Saturday Night– Southbrook Pub (4km from Strongfield Stud)
 - Lunch (BBQ sausage sizzle) and drinks will be available on site on both days for a small fee.
 - -The kettle and BBQ will be available for competitors to use throughout the weekend.
- Camping and Facilities There is plenty of camping space at Strongfield Stud and there are toilets and hand basins in the camping grounds. Showers with warm water are also available for use on site.
 -240V power is also available near the camping grounds for charging phones etc.
- Yards—Competitors are welcome to bring their own yards. There are a number of day yards available for use. Competitors use yards at their own risk. Numbers are limited, so please indicate if you require the use of a yard on the entry form. There will be no extra fee for the use of yards.
- Water Bore water is available for use and there are taps located near the yards and stables. Bring your own water containers for your horses. There is a concrete wash bay with a hose for washing horses. Fresh tank water is also available for human drinking water only.
- **Dogs** Dogs may be permitted by prior negotiation with the property owners.
- Loading Ramp An earth loading ramp is located near the camping ground to load/unload carriages
 and horses if needed.







CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

This event will be conducted under the F.E.I. Rules for Driving Events as at 1st January 2016 with variations and additional regulations included in this schedule.

Drivers in Championship classes must be participant or competitor members of EA. Drivers in unofficial classes must be Warwick Club members or EA members. A restricted membership form for this event must be completed for drivers who are not Warwick Club members or EA members. Club Receipts or current Membership Cards (Club or EA) must be available for checking if required to receive Competitors Kits. Horses are not required to be registered with EA.

All competitors and their navigators/grooms compete at their own risk. The organising committee and land holders accept no responsibility for loss or damage to horses, owners, passengers, equipment, drivers, grooms or spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever, whilst at or near the venue, during the course of this event. All competitors, by entering this event, agree to be bound by this regulation.

All child/junior drivers between 12 and 18 years must be accompanied by a capable groom 18 years or over in all phases of the competition. Whenever a child/junior is in a vehicle they must be wearing an equestrian type helmet that complies with EA requirements.

Carriage weight restrictions and track widths are not enforced at this event. Conflict of interest rules (article 984 point 3) are not enforced at this event.

Appeals, together with \$20, are to be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the scores being posted for each phase. Money may be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.

The organisers reserve the right to:

- Alter any advertised times;
- Refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason;
- Refuse admission to any person whose attendance may, in the opinion of the Organising Committee, impose a risk on the person, or to Warwick Club and EA members, or members of the public; or due to inappropriate behavior or failure to comply with the Club's and EA expected standard of behavior;
- Measure any horse or pony upon discretion
- Reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class

Entry fees must accompany nominations.

The event will be run on time. Any competitor late for a scheduled starting time will be awarded time penalties. In the event of an accident, or any other occurrence beyond the control of the competitor, contact the Secretary to arrange an alternate starting time.

Organisers reserve the right to penalize competitors for unsafe practices.

Back protectors are required in the combined marathon for all drivers and grooms.

The wearing of equestrian helmets complying with required standards is mandatory.

It is a condition of entry that competitors hand to the organisers a Horse Health Declaration Form before you receive your competitors kit.
