HORSE OF THE YEAR

(Classes 1 – 20) are the classes that qualify horses/riders for the 2017 Australasian Show Horse & Rider Championships

- Class 1: Rider of the Year under 12years
- Class 2: Rider of the Year 12 to 14 years
- Class 3: Rider of the Year 15 to 17 years
- Class 4: Rider of the Year 18 years and over
- Class 5: Small Show Pony of the Year 12.0hh and under (rider 14 years and under)
- Class 6: Medium Show Pony of the Year over 12.0hh n.e. 13.0hh
- Class 7: Large Show Pony of the Year over 13.0hh n.e. 14.0hh
- Class 8: Small Galloway of the Year over 14.0hh n.e. 14.2hh
- Class 9: Large Galloway of the Year over 14.2hh n.e. 15.0hh
- Class 10: Small Hack of the Year over 15.0hh n.e. 16.0hh
- Class 11: Large Hack of the Year over 16.0hh
- Class 12: Small Show Hunter Pony of the Year 12.0hh and under (rider 14 years and under)
- Class 13: Medium Show Hunter Pony of the Year over 12.0hh n.e. 13.0hh
- Class 14: Large Show Hunter Pony of the Year over 13.0hh n.e. 14.0hh
- Class 15: Small Show Hunter Galloway of the Year over 14.0hh n.e. 14.2.hh
- Class 16: Large Show Hunter Galloway of the Year over 14.2hh n.e. 15hh
- Class 17: Small Show Hunter Hack of the Year over 15.0hh n.e. 16.0hh
- Class 18: Large Show Hunter Hack of the Year over 16.0hh
- Class 19: Lead Rein Show Pony n.e. 12.0hh (riders 5 years & under 8 years)
- Class 20: Lead Rein Hunter Pony n.e. 12.0hh (riders 5 years & under 8 years)

All winners from classes 1-20 will receive a v-shaped sash, woolen embroidered rug and a garland. All runner-ups from classes 1-20 will receive a v-shaped sash and a cotton embroidered rug. All third place-getters from classes 1-20 will receive a v-shaped sash. All smartest on parade and top ten place-getters from classes 1-20 will receive a ribbon. All Show Horse and Show Hunter Classes will be your own workout for 2 and a half minutes only.

All riders must supply their own music.

Rider Classes will have a set workout but will also need music to be 2mins only.

Equestrian Australia Rules and EQ Conditions of Entry

1. Rules

It is the responsibility of all owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees to be familiar with and aware of all Equestrian Australia rules which govern this sport. For example; the constitution, by-law and policies consist of, but are not limited to: Codes of Conduct, Equine Anti-Doping and Medication Control Regulations. All owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees, entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be financial members of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. and all horses entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be registered with the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. Such membership/registrations shall be effective by time of entry. At least (1) Owner/Lessee must be a financial Member of EQ for horses. All Horses/Ponies must be domiciled in Qld (and within a 100km radius of the boarder) for a total period of 3 months immediately preceding the date of the HOTY Event.

2. Contact with Appointed Judge/s

If it is brought to the attention of the organizing committee that any owner/rider/exhibitor/lessee has been in contact with and/or makes contact with an appointed judge at any stage throughout the duration of the show, that owner/rider/exhibitor/lessee will automatically forfeit their right to entry.

3. Protests

All protests must be submitted in writing to the ringmaster no later than sixty (60) minutes following the completion of the class in question. All protests shall be accompanied by a cash fee of \$150.00 which shall be forfeited should the protest be deemed frivolous or the protest is dismissed.

4. Payments

Payments are NON-REFUNDABLE at closure date and NON-TRANSFERABLE (Transferable entry money may be considered with a vet certificate)

5. Prize/s

Any prize/s not collected on the day of the show will be forfeited.

- 6. All owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees, entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be financial members of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. and all horses entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be registered with the Equestrian Australia Inc. Such membership/registrations shall be effective by close of entries.
- 7. All Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration forms must be submitted to the show secretary on the day of the show, prior to the commencement of classes. For health declaration follow link:

8. Owner Rider Rules and Regulations:

- 1. All riders/owners/leasees, entered or competing in the ridden Equestrian Queensland Show must be financial members of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. and all horses entered or competing in the ridden Equestrian Queensland Show must be registered with the Equestrian Australia Inc. Such membership/registrations shall be effective by close of entries.
- 2. All horses and ponies to have an official EA/EQ lease or be the bona fide property of the rider. An official lease must have been in existence for a period of at least three months prior to the show for the owner-rider classes.
- 3. Horses and ponies must not have been ridden, trained or exhibited under saddle by any other person in the previous three months. The only exception being those horses and ponies which have been ridden by another person who qualifies as an owner-rider (subject to rule 2)

9. **Childrens Classes** (in addition to the above rules)

- a. Horses and ponies must be Registered with Equestrian Australia and domiciled in Queensland for at least three months prior to the date of this show.
- b. Horses and ponies entered in the child classes can be an open horse or pony but must be ridden by a child.
- c. All children riders must be under 18 years of age.
- 10. All owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees, entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be financial members of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. and all horses entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be registered with the Equestrian Australia Inc. Such membership/registrations shall be effective by close of entries.
- 11. All Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration forms must be submitted to the show secretary on the day of the show, prior to the commencement of classes. For health declaration follow link:

12: All Horses must be Gear Checked before entry into the ring by a Gear Steward.

13: Helmets must be the correct code and are required to be presented for inspection on the day.

14. Responsible person must be in attendance on the day and also must nominate this person when entering your horse on Nominate. Responsible Person must either be the owner/exhibitor.

• Riders must be either Competitor or Participant EA members at time of entry and competition.

- Owners must be Competitor, Participant or Supporter EA members at time of entry and competition.
- Class: open to exhibits registered and named on the Australian Stud Book (ASB) that have started in

a race or official barrier trial on any registered racetrack in Australia or abroad on or after 1st January
