WHAT IS A PARA EQUESTRIAN?

“A Para Equestrian is a rider with a physical or visual disability that satisfies the minimal impact criteria as detailed in the FEI PE Classification Manual and has been classified by an accredited National Classifier for National Competition” e.g. 1. Each rider must have more than 15% loss of power, range or coordination in any limb or the trunk; and 2. Each rider must have a recognised medical condition that causes impairment which can be measured objectively
