Equestrian Australia Rules and EQ Conditions of Entry

1. Rules

It is the responsibility of all owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees to be familiar with and aware of all Equestrian Australia rules which govern this sport. For example; the constitution, by-law and policies consist of, but are not limited to: Codes of Conduct, Equine Anti-Doping and Medication Control Regulations.

All owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees, entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be financial members of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. and all horses entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be registered with the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. Such membership/registrations shall be effective by time of entry.

All Horses/Ponies must be domiciled in Qld (and within a 100km radius of the boarder) for a total period of 3 months immediately preceding the date of the HOTA Event.

2. Contact with Appointed Judge/s

If it is brought to the attention of the organizing committee that any owner/rider/exhibitor/lessee has been in contact with and/or makes contact with an appointed judge at any stage throughout the duration of the show, that owner/rider/exhibitor/lessee will automatically forfeit their right to entry.

3. Protests

All protests must be submitted in writing to the ringmaster no later than sixty (60) minutes following the completion of the class in question. All protests shall be accompanied by a cash fee of \$150.00 which shall be forfeited should the protest be deemed frivolous.

4. Payments

Payments are NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE.

5. Prize/s

Any prize/s not collected on the day of the show will be forfeited.

6. Newcomer HOTA (in addition to the above rules)

- a. Newcomer HOTA is open to horses and ponies which have NOT debuted in any under saddle class at any event (excluding racing), which includes but is not limited to – breed, local, pony club, dressage, jumping etc. prior to 1st July 2016.
- b. Horses and ponies which have competed under saddle in any event in any state (excluding racing) prior to 1st July 2016 are not eligible to compete.
- c. All horses and ponies are to be ridden in a simple snaffle bridle. Nosebands may be cavesson, hanoverian or drop, as per EA rules.
- d. Horses and ponies must be 3yrs of age or over at 1 August.
- e. All owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees must be Current financial members at the time of entry.
- f. There is no domicile rule for Newcomer Horses and Ponies.

7. **Intermediate HOTY** (in addition to the above rules)

- a. Intermediate HOTY is open to horses and ponies which have NOT won or runner-up at any EA State HOTY (including Intermediate and open HOTY), or won 1st, 2nd in any open hack or open show hunter class at any Royal Show.
- b. Horses and ponies must be owned/leased and domiciled in Queensland for at least three months prior to the date of this show.
- c. All owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees must be bonafide residents of Queensland for at least three months prior to the date of this show.
- d. All Horses/Ponies must be 3 years of age or over at 1 August.

8. **Owner Rider Rules and Regulations:**

1. All riders and owners and leasees, entered or competing in the ridden Equestrian Queensland Show must be financial members of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. and all horses entered or competing in the ridden Equestrian Queensland Show must be registered with the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. Such membership/registrations shall be effective by close of entries.
2. All horses and ponies to have an official EA/EQ lease or be the bona fide property of the rider. An official lease must have been in existence for a period of at least three months prior to the show for the owner-rider classes.
3. Horses and ponies must not have been ridden, trained or exhibited under saddle by any other person in the previous three months. The only exception being those horses and ponies which have been ridden by another person who qualifies as an owner-rider (subject to rule 2)

9. **Childrens Classes** (in addition to the above rules)

- a. Horses and ponies must be Registered with Equestrian Queensland and domiciled in Queensland for at least three months prior to the date of this show.
- b. Horses and ponies entered in the child classes can be an open horse or pony but must be ridden by a child.
- c. All children riders must be under 18 years of age as at the 1st January 2017.

10. All owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees, entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be a full financial members of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. and all horses entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be registered with the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. Such membership/registrations shall be effective by close of entries.

11. All Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration forms must be submitted to the show secretary on the day of the show, prior to the commencement of classes. For health declaration follow link:

12: All Horses must be **Gear Checked** before entry into the ring by a Gear Steward.
