## Scratchings

- Scratchings will be accepted prior to closing date and the administration fee will apply.
- No refund for scratching after close of entries unless accompanied by a vet/medical certificate within 7 days of start of competition and will attract a 30% administration fee. ## Cancellation of Event

- In the event of cancellation of the competition or part thereof, due to circumstances beyond the control of the OC, entry fee will be refunded less 25% to help defray costs already incurred.
- This event will not be rescheduled if cancelled.

## Helper Roster

- It is a condition of entry that each rider must provide the name and contact details of a helper for each discipline entered.
- ***The helper roster will be available at the event. If a nominated helper or substitute does not present on the day, the riders scores will not be submitted to State office for qualifying and will be scored as HC.***

## Draw

- A draw will be available on Nominate. Any errors must be advised to the relevant discipline convenors emails asap before the event.

## Substitutions

- Riders may substitute a horse in the same class up until the start of competition for the day, providing proof of IQ registration is presented to the organising committee, and the request is accompanied by a veterinary certificate.
- Substitution of rider is not permitted.

### Conditions of entry

- This competition is run in accordance with the 2017 IQ Handbook and therefore EA rules apply. This handbook is available on the IQ website at <http://www.qld.equestrian.org.au/interschool/sites/default/files/IQ%20HANDBOOK%202017%20FINAL.pdf>
- All schools represented must be current financial members of IQ. Riders who are not financial members of EQ at the time of competition will not be able to compete in this Championship.

### Reservation of rights

- The Organising Committee reserves the right to:
  - Cancel any class or event
  - Divide or combine any class
  - Transfer competitors between classes
  - Alter the advertised times
  - Refuse entry to any competitor with or without stating the reason

### Disputes

- No competitors or parents or coaches are to directly approach any judges, stewards, course builders or any other officials or volunteers with disputes, complaints or queries.
- Any disputes, complaints or queries during the competition must be lodged in writing with the Organising Committee through the School Convenor with a fee of \$50 within 30 minutes after the happening which gave rise to the objection.
- These will be referred to the Technical Delegate/Ground Jury of the day.
- The decision of the Technical Delegate/Ground Jury will be final and may not be appealed.

### Ground Jury

- This will be made up of the most senior judge/official of the day and President of SEQ.

### Photo Release Waiver

- By participating in this event you are consenting to your child/children being photographed or filmed. EQ may use these images for promotional use in the Interschool program, this includes but is not limited to, use on the EQ website, marketing material and in all forms of media. I understand photos in which my child/children appear may be submitted to EQ, partners and stakeholders who may also use these images for the purpose of promoting their association with EQ.

### Horse Health Declarations

- All riders must supply a completed horse health declaration asap after arrival at the grounds and you will be issued with an armband. **No armband = No ride**
- A copy of this will be available when the draw goes up on Nominate, please print it off, fill out and bring it with you.

### Vehicles other than cars and trucks

- Motor bikes, four wheelers, trikes or other such vehicles will not be permitted on the grounds unless by previous arrangement. Queensland Road Rules will apply to all drivers and vehicles.

### **Stables/yards and camping**

- Stables are available at a cost of \$50 for the event.
- Yards are available at a cost of \$25 for the event
- Camping is available at a cost of \$10 per day.
- Stables and yards are not situated in the same area at the showgrounds.
- Stables will be pre-allocated and advised before the event.
- Non-competition horses are not permitted on the grounds.
- Yards are on a first in first served basis.
- No electric tape or portable yards to be used.
- **Stables and yards MUST be cleaned/emptied before departure.**
- Stables do not have sawdust in them on arrival. You can bring your own or pre-order from the local produce – Beaudesert Rural Supplies 149 Helen Street 5541 2344. Orders must be placed before the weekend to ensure they have enough sawdust in stock.
- NO SAWDUST IN YARDS PLEASE
- Camping is not pre-allocated.
- Feed supplies and hay can be ordered prior and delivered to the show grounds from Beaudesert Rural Supplies 5541 2344.

### **Presentations**

- Unmounted presentation will be held at the conclusion of each day. ***As is the nature of these events this can sometimes be quite late in the afternoon so please plan ahead for this.***

### **Dogs**

- No pets are permitted on the grounds during this competition as per Beaudesert Show Society conditions.

- Maximum of 2 horses per rider.

- Senior is defined as those athletes turning 15,16,17&18 years of age in the current year.
- A maximum of one class ie two tests per horse/rider combination.

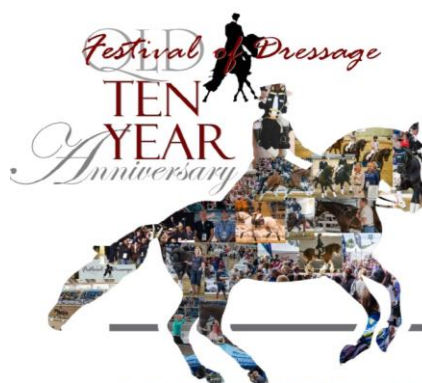
