#### **<u>Dress for Competition days:</u>** Official EA Summer Dress requirements

#### EA Jumping Rules: Article 256 - Dress, Headgear and Salute

1.5 Athletes are required to wear the uniform or dress approved by their NF. The summer dress white or light fawn breeches, black or brown boots. A white tie, ratcatcher, or a hunting stock and a white or lightly coloured shirt must be worn. Shirts may have long or short sleeves and must have a white collar; long-sleeved shirts must have white cuffs. If a jacket is not worn shirts must have sleeves, either short or long sleeves are permitted

**Dress for Training Days:** tidy collared shirt will be allowed.

#### **Rules:**

Art. 274.5.6 = This competition comprises two phases run without interruption, each at an identical or different speed, the finishing line for the first phase being identical with the starting line for the second phase. Unless eliminated, Athletes penalised in the first phase may continue in the second phase.

## **Express eventing-**

Consists of a Show Jumping course and then straight into a shortened XC course including some technical jumps, Apexes, arrowheads, brushes, flower beads and the like (roughly 6-9 efforts) in a confined area, making it a tough challenge but great pre-season run, this will be marked the same as a normal ODE so you could encounter 20 penalties for a run out or refusal and/or time faults...You need to wear your body protector to compete in this class

#### <u>Insurance</u>

All riders should note that unless you are a registered Equestrian Australia Riding member then the only insurance in place is that supplied by the Tamborine Equestrian Group Inc. and is a basic Public Liability Insurance only.
