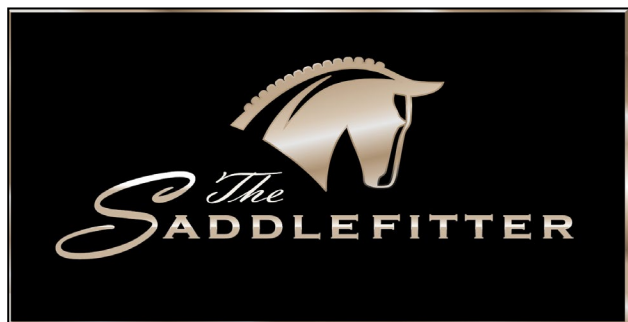

Prize money will be processed within approx. 14 working days post the event. Any outstanding debts will be deducted from prize money. Prize money is awarded to the owners or lessees of horses. Competitors **must** provide Bank Account details so that funds can be transferred into the nominated bank account. Failure to provide correct bank details will result in deduction of a \$25.00 administration fee from prizes paid.

Prize money.

- For National competitions prize money will be paid in accordance with EA Rule 3.20, that is, one prize for every 5 starters. Prize money to first only if less than 5 starters.
- For CDN Freestyles prize money will be paid as per the table on page 3, except where there are less than 8 entries. In the event there are 8 or less entries prize money for CDN Freestyles will be paid to 3rd place.
- For CDI competitions prize money will be paid as per the FEI-approved schedule.
- There is no prize money for participant competitions

- Scores (percentages) of team members will be added together to determine team scores. The winning team will be the team with the highest total score; the second one, the next highest, etc.
- One combination at each level is required to make up a team of three riders.
- A horse and/or rider may only be represented once in each team. A rider may only compete in one team per Team competition.
- **This is not a STATE TEAMS competition and teams can be made up of riders from any state**
- Team declarations must be made to the event office no later than **5pm Wednesday September 16th**

Teams Competition entry fee: Nil

Special Awards:

- **Dressage Queensland Regional Rider Award:** This award is donated by Dressage Queensland and is designed to encourage riders travelling from regional areas of Queensland. Riders are classed as regional when they reside more than 400kms from the Brisbane CBD. (by road, shortest direct route)
The Regional Rider prize will be awarded to the highest placed regional rider based on their best two placings in any competition from Preliminary to Grand Prix, including the GP Special. Freestyles are not eligible. Riders are to nominate by contacting the event organiser brisbanecdievent@gmail.com by September 16th if they wish to enter for this award. No entry fee is required. For a rider on multiple horses, each horse will be a separate entry. In the case of equality, the horse with the highest aggregate percentage is the winner.
- **Young Rider Awards:** Rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed Young Riders 1-6th in each national competition (excluding freestyles). There will not be separate young rider champions awarded.
- **Best Performed Off the Track Horse:** This award is sponsored by Queensland Off the Track.
The Best Performed Off the Track Thoroughbred will be awarded to the highest placed off the track horse based on its best two placings in any competition from Preliminary to Grand Prix, including the GP Special. Freestyles are not eligible. Riders are to nominate via Nominate.com.au if they wish to enter for this award. No entry fee is required. Riders will be required to submit their horse's registered racing name. This award is open to both Thoroughbred and Standardbred ex-racehorses.
- **Best Performed CDN Big Tour AOR Rider:** Will be calculated from the CDN Intermediate II and Grand Prix as per rule 3.19i. Rosette and rug to the best performed AOR combination competing in the CDN Intermediate II and CDN GP.

Conditions of Entry

CDI 3* GP, CDI-Ch, CDI-P, CDI-J, CDI-Y and CDI-U25 Competitions – will be conducted in accordance with current FEI Statutes, General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations and Dressage Rules.

National Competitions – will be held in accordance with the current EA Rules, Policies and Regulations.

MEMBERSHIP & HORSE REGISTRATION

- Riders entered in all EA & CDN competitions must be current Competitive members of EA. Horses/Ponies must have EA Life Registration and have a current Dressage Performance Card/Competition Licence
- **FEI Horse and Rider registration:** All riders and horses participating in FEI sanctioned events (CDI 3*, CDI-U25, CDI-Y, CDI-J, CDI-P and CDI-Ch competitions) must be registered on the FEI database. Horses must have an official current FEI Passport or National Passport approved by the FEI (FEI Gen. Regs. Art. 137). Ensure your FEI Athlete and Horse registrations are current for 2026.
- **CDI 3* GP, CDI-Ch, CDI-P, CDI-J, CDI-Y, CDI-U25:** Riders may participate **only** under the **jurisdiction of the country with which they hold their passport**.
- Entries without the correct documents can't be entered into the FEI entry system.
- Check that your horse's passport and/or FEI Recognition Card are current. If they are due to expire prior to the event, they must be renewed. *Allow up to 4 weeks for this process.*
- Planning on competing at FEI level for the first time? You will need to order your FEI Registrations and Horse's passport well in advance.

ENTRIES & PERFORMANCE

- **Rider Age: CDI 3* – Open to riders** from the year in which they reach their **16th birthday**. **CDI-Ch**: Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of **12** until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of **14**. **CDI-P**: Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of **12** until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of **16**. **CDI-J**: Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of **14** until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of **18**. **CDI-Y**: Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of **16** until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of **21**. **CDI-U25**: Open to riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of **16** until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of **25**.
- **CDI entries**: horses may take part in **one competition per day** and may not start in a national competition from the start time of the horse inspection until the day after completing their last international competition. (FEI Dressage Rules, Art. 405)
- **Eligibility & Performance:**
 - All qualifying performances must be from Official Competitive competitions. The qualifying period is **9 August 2025 to 9 August 2026**; performances outside of this range may be accepted at the discretion of the OC.
 - **CDI3* Grand Prix**: At least one performance of 62% or higher in Grand Prix competition (not including GP Special or Freestyle)
 - **CDI-Ch**: One performance of 60% or higher at Novice level (FEI-Ch Preliminary or Team test performances accepted)
 - **CDI-P**: One performance of 60% or higher % at Elementary level (FEI-P Individual or Team test performances accepted)
 - **CDI-J**: One performance of 60% or higher at Medium level (FEI-J Individual or Team test performances accepted)
 - **CDI-Y**: One performance of 60% or higher at PSG/Inter I level (FEI-Y Individual or Team test performances accepted)
 - **CDI-U25**: One performance of 60% or higher at Intermediate A, Intermediate B, Intermediate II or Grand Prix.
 - **CDN Prix St Georges Open**: One performance of 60% or higher at Prix St Georges.
 - **CDN Intermediate I Open**: One performance of 60% or higher at Intermediate I.
 - **CDN Intermediate A/B Open**: One performance of 60% or higher at Intermediate A or B.
 - **CDN Intermediate II**: One performance of 60% or higher at Intermediate II.
 - **CDN Grand Prix**: One performance of 60% or higher in Grand Prix competition.
 - **Preliminary to Advanced (Open, AOR and Pony) and AOR/Pony FEI**: Acceptance of nominations will not be conditional on submission of qualification scores. Where available, one score at the respective level should be submitted for balloting purposes in the case of competition oversubscription. Please note performance/s must have been gained in **official EA competitive competitions**. One HC (Hors Concours) score is allowed to count as a balloting score at each level entered. In the event of oversubscription of a competition, ranking (balloting) will be based on the highest percentage at that level as submitted by close of entry. Preference will be given first to those who have submitted Official Competitive EA scores at the time of entry.
 - Entries will be accepted on merit **or** at the discretion of the Organising Committee
 - Where more than one score is available, at least one qualifying score must be obtained by the nominated horse/rider combination. The OC will consider exceptions in special circumstances only.
 - AOR riders must meet the criteria outlined in Rule 4.6.1 (EA National Dressage Rules)
 - Entrants in pony competitions must hold a current EA pony height certificate
- The **number of horses or ponies per rider per competition** may be limited.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to allocate 'wildcard entries' at each level in exceptional circumstances for national competitions only.
- A combination may only enter either AOR competitions OR Pony competitions OR Open competitions at this event.
- Any relevant EA Exemption Cards must be emailed to brisbanecdievent@gmail.com at the time of entry.
- The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries as per Article 109 and 116.4 in the EA General Regulations. For EA competitions, HC entries will only be accepted where the competition is not over-subscribed. Where a competition has a reserve list HC entries will automatically be placed at the bottom of the reserve list.
- **CALLERS**: are not permitted.
- Horses entered for CDI-J, CDI-Y and CDI3* competitions must have a height at the withers **exceeding 149cms** including shoes.
- Ponies entered for CDI-P competition must have a height at the withers **not exceeding 149cms** including shoes and hold a current EA pony height certificate.
- Both horses and ponies are eligible for the CDI-Ch competitions.
- Ponies may enter Advanced and CDN Freestyle competitions provided they meet the qualifying criteria, however there will not be separate pony placings.
- **Horse/Pony Age**: Horses/Ponies must be at least 6 years of age for CDI-Ch, CDI-P and CDI-J, 7 years of age for PSG, Int I & CDI-Y. For tests above Inter I horses must be a minimum of 8 years of age.
- **Entry Fees**: Refer pages 3& 4.
- **Combinations** entered in the **CDI-P, CDI-J, CDI-Y, and CDI-U25** must enter all three competitions at their level.
- **Combinations** entered in the **CDI-Ch** must enter both competitions at that level.
- **CDI3* GP** riders may enter and ride up to two horses in the Grand Prix, Grand Prix Special and Grand Prix Freestyle (providing they qualify).
- **Combinations** entered in the EA Preliminary to Advanced must enter both competitions at a level.
- Late entries, faxed and phone entries will not be accepted, except in exceptional circumstances and accompanied by a \$100.00 late entry fee.

FREESTYLES & GRAND PRIX SPECIAL

- **Advanced Freestyle**: The top 12 (AOR, Pony & Open) combined percentages from the **Advanced 5B & 5C** qualify to ride the Advanced Freestyle (if entered).
- **Intermediate I Freestyle**: The top 15 placegetters in the Open PstG or Intermediate I qualify to ride the Intermediate I Freestyle (if entered) however a horse must earn a minimum score of **60%** in the qualifying competition to be eligible. The Organising Committee is free to invite the best combinations in the AOR & Pony PstG/Intermediate I (if entered), provided they have met the minimum score.
- **FEI Intermediate A/B Freestyle**: The top 10 combinations in the Open Intermediate A or B which have scored **60%** or more will be eligible (if entered). The Organising Committee is free to invite the best combinations in the AOR & Pony Intermediate A/Intermediate B (if entered), provided they have met the minimum score.

- **CDN Grand Prix Freestyle:** The top 15 combinations in the CDN Grand Prix which have scored **60%** or more will be eligible (if entered). The Organising Committee is free to invite the best combinations in the Pony Grand Prix (if entered), provided they have met the minimum score.
- **CDN Grand Prix Special** (same conditions for CDN Grand Prix Freestyle).
- **CDI-P Freestyle:** Compulsory for the top 12 combinations from the Pony Rider Individual competition which have scored a minimum score of **60%** in the CDI-P Individual.
- **CDI-J Freestyle:** Compulsory for the top 12 combinations from the Junior Rider Individual competition which have scored a minimum score of **60%** in the CDI-J Individual.
- **CDI-Y Freestyle:** Compulsory for the top 12 combinations from the Young Rider Individual competition which have scored a minimum score of **60%** in the CDI-Y Individual competition.
- **GP CDI-U25 Freestyle:** Compulsory for the top 6 combinations from the CDI-U25 Grand Prix competition which have scored a minimum score of **60%** in the CDI-U25 Grand Prix.
- **CDI 3* Grand Prix Special:** all entered combinations are eligible for the Grand Prix Special.
- **CDI 3* Grand Prix Freestyle:** the top 15 placegetters in the CDI3* Grand Prix qualify however a horse must earn a minimum average score of **60%** in the CDI3*GP to qualify.
- Freestyle Music to be submitted prior to the event via a link that will be provided after close of entries. Freestyle Music testing will take place by appointment on Friday September 18th or by other arrangement.
- Entry fees will be refunded for those who enter and do not qualify for the Freestyle.

CDI 3* GP, CDI-Ch, CDI-P, CDI-J, CDI-Y, & CDI-U25 HORSE INSPECTIONS & VETERINARY EXAMINATION

- **Horse Registration Control and Veterinary Examination and Inspection all horses/ponies:** These will be carried out in accordance with current FEI Veterinary Regulations and General Regulations and Dressage Rules. Horse/pony Registration control and **veterinary examination** will take place Thursday, 17th September 2026, time to be advised with competitor information pack. The fitness inspection ("trot up") will take place on **Thursday, 17th September**, at approx. **4.30pm (TBC)**. Details will be provided with the competitor information pack. All horses/ponies entered in the CDI 3* GP, CDI-Ch, CDI-P, CDI-J, CDI-Y, and CDI-U25 are required to trot-up.

MEDICATION CONTROL, INSURANCE AND FARRIER

- **Sampling procedure for Prohibited substances** –. Horses/ponies will be subject to sampling for Prohibited Substances. If approached by the Official Veterinary Surgeon or an Official from the OC, the competitor must allow samples to be taken from their horse/pony for drug testing. Riders must have their EA documents ready to provide to officials should their horse be selected for swabbing.
- **Insurance:** All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals. They are therefore strongly advised to take out a third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.
- **Veterinary & Farrier:** Services will be available on call. Contact details will be provided with the competitor information pack.

DECLARATION OF STARTERS (CDI 3* GP, CDI-Ch, CDI-P, CDI-J, CDI-Y, & CDI-U25)

- Declaration of starters: must be done by 1 hour after the Horse Inspection for Friday competitions, then midday for each following day's competitions. Riders who have not declared by the deadline will be considered as starters for the competitions entered at the closing date of entries.

TIME DRAWS

- CDI 3* GP, CDI-Ch, CDI-P, CDI-J, CDI-Y, CDI-U25 Friday competitions: an ordinary draw will take place as soon as possible after the Fitness Inspection on Thursday 18th September and will be placed on the event Facebook page and also published to the web site.
- The draw for National competitions will be an ordinary draw and will be available at www.qld.equestrian.org.au/dressage/brisbane-cdi

WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS

- **Refer EA rule 10.4:** Withdrawals must be notified to the OC as soon as possible. Withdrawals at the event must complete a withdrawal form available at the Event Office.
- **Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 3 days of the completion of the event. In such cases, 50% of the entry fees will be retained by the OC.
- **As per EA rule 4.3 d no refunds will be given for withdrawals/scratchings advised from the day prior to commencement of the event**, that is from Wed Sept 16th.
- Entry fees will be refunded in full as soon as possible for withdrawals before the closing date of entries. Entry fees for riders on the reserve list who are not offered a start in a competition will be refunded after the event.
- **The administration fee will not be refunded under any circumstance.**
- **CDI riders are reminded that all withdrawals must come through the OC for approval by the Head of the Ground Jury.** Withdrawal or failure to present without prior written notification and approval may result in a yellow card or FEI sanctions.

PRESENTATIONS

- **Presentations** will be **unmounted** except for the CDI-P Freestyle, CDI-J Freestyle, CDI-Y Freestyle, CDI-U25 Grand Prix Freestyle, Intermediate I Freestyle, CDN Grand Prix Freestyle, CDI 3* Grand Prix Freestyle, Intermediate A/B Freestyle, Advanced Freestyle, - these will be **mounted**.
- Participation in prize-giving ceremonies is **compulsory**. Failure to do so entails losing the classification (sash, prize in kind, prize money FEI Dressage Rules Art.427),

ACCREDITATION

One rider, one rider's partner, one groom per horse and two owners per horse will gain accreditation to the event – accreditation will be limited in the case of the rider's partner being the groom or owner. Please collect from the **Riders Office** outside the indoor. This pass allows daily access to the venue and stables.

STABLING

- Powered & Unpowered Camp sites are available with good amenities available.
- Stables and Camping are booked with your entries. **Stables and Camp Sites will be allocated by the OC.**
- **CDI 3* GP, CDI-Ch, CDI-P, CDI-J, CDI-Y & CDI-U25** - FEI Rules require horses to remain on the competition grounds for the duration of the event (*from the "Fitness Inspection until the horse has finished competing"*). Owners and riders of CDI horses that leave the grounds prior to completion of their competitions may be subject to FEI sanctions. This rule does not apply to horses taking part in National competitions.
- **Day parking (tying to float/truck) is not permitted in the QSEC camping area at this event.** Riders competing in the indoor arena can day park on Parklands Park 2.
- Excellent stables are available on the grounds, 3.6m x 3.6m with anti-slip rubber matting and bitumen isles. 1/3 cubic metre (6-7 wheelbarrows) of shavings is included in the stable hire fee. Stables will be pre-filled. More bedding can be ordered from Caboolture Feedmania (07) 5495 1961
- Stables are charged per day, i.e. if arriving Thursday and departing Friday this is 2 days of stabling.
- All stallions are to be stabled. Please note EA Stallion Safe Practice Rules and Regulations Policy
- A stable allocation will apply and no horses are to be moved except if instructed to by Stable Manager.
- All horses staying overnight must be stabled.
- Private tack rooms will be allocated ONLY if sufficient spare stables are available.
- There is a compulsory stable bond per stable and tack room. If stables and tack rooms are not left swept clean of all bedding, manure, urine and other waste, this bond will be retained. All stables must be inspected by the Stable Manager prior to departure for a "clean pass".
- **Competitors** are responsible for paying any damages incurred to stables during the event - **fee as determined by QSEC.**
- **Day Parking** (tie to float) is permitted for those competing in competitions at the outdoor arenas or day yards may be hired. **Competitions at the outdoor arenas are Open, AOR, Pony & Participant Preliminary, Novice and Elementary**
- All competitors must complete a '**Horse Health Declaration Form**' before unloading horses at QSEC. A copy of this form can be found here <https://qsec.com.au/files/assets/qsec/forms/horse-health-declaration-form.pdf>
- **STABLE PROTOCOL: SMOKING is not permitted in the stables!** Prams, bicycles, scooters & golf buggies are not permitted in the stables (exception – vehicles used by Stable Manager & venue staff). Children under 12 must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. For safety reasons we recommend that all persons including children wear closed footwear whilst in the stables.
- **Arrival & Departure:** The earliest horses can arrive is Tuesday September 15th, 9.00am, unless prior permission is arranged. The latest departure from the venue is Sunday September 20th, unless prior permission is arranged.

CATERING: Catering will be available on the grounds from Breakfast on Thursday morning.

DOGS: Dogs are ONLY allowed in the QSEC camping grounds. This does not include Barr Oval, the indoor precinct including the grassed area outside or carparks or within the stable blocks. Dogs MUST be kept on a lead (maximum length of 1 metre) and under control at all times. Dogs are not permitted in the shower/ toilet/laundry facilities. Any person not adhering to this guideline will be asked to leave the grounds immediately and no refund given. Please ensure that dog droppings are disposed of using the bags provided. Do not bring dangerous dogs to this event.

QSEC Policy:

Please note QSEC has a **no glass** policy. This includes glass jars, bottles and any glass products. Only alcohol purchased at the venue can be consumed at the Indoor Precinct.

Measuring:

Pony measuring will be available at this event. Details will be provided in the competitors notes.

VACCINATIONS

There are no vaccination requirements to enter this event. However, we strongly recommend that tetanus and strangles vaccines are up to date for every horse attending this event. We also strongly encourage owners of horses that reside in high risk areas to vaccinate against the Hendra Virus. Riders are required to advise the Hendra vaccination status of their horses on the entry form.

Riders and owners of horses who are not currently protected against Hendra Virus should be aware that veterinarians may refuse to treat horses until an exclusion test has shown that they do not have Hendra Virus.

QUEENSLAND TICK REQUIREMENTS: The event committee will attempt to have QSEC certified as a tick-free venue prior to the event starting. If this is not possible, spraying arrangements for horses returning to tick free areas and Interstate will be organised to allow horses to be sprayed at QSEC prior to departure.

PROPERTY IDENTIFICATION CODE: It is compulsory to provide a PIC with your entry.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Code of conduct: The organising committee of the Brisbane CDI and Queensland Dressage Championships values the attendance of all riders, officials, spectators, sponsors, volunteers and supporters HOWEVER it is a condition of attendance at this event that each person present on the grounds is bound by the rules, policies and by-laws of Equestrian Australia. This includes comments made on social media. Any complaints or conflicts should be managed with respect through official channels. As per EA Disciplinary By-Laws 3(j) any other person or organisation (for example, a parent/guardian, spectator or sponsor) who or which agrees, in writing or otherwise (whether on a ticket, entry form, conditions of entry displayed at a venue etc) to be bound by these By-Laws. Any rider, parent, official or associate to be found in breach of these By-Laws will be requested to leave the venue immediately and all entry fees and prizes deemed forfeit.

Welfare of the Horse

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**

All competitors, in entering, undertake to accept this regulation

Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted undertake to indemnify the committee against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the committee to be negligent shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity. Riders are required to acknowledge the Declaration form included on nominate.com.au. Failure to agree to this condition will result in non-acceptance of the nomination.

Reservation of rights

The OC reserves the rights to alter, amend and to refuse any entry, with or without stating reasons
