TRADE VENDOR NEWSLETTER

Thank you for supporting the 2026 Saddlefitter Brisbane CDI & Queensland Dressage Championships. The Trade Village adds tremendously to the atmosphere of the event and your efforts to be at our event are greatly appreciated. Below is some information to help ensure the event runs as seamlessly for you as possible and also some requests for information.

1. The Qld State Equestrian Centre is a **GLASS FREE VENUE**. This means if you sell any merchandise that is made of glass, and please make sure it is well packaged ideally in bubble wrap.
2. **Bump In & Bump Out:** Bump in can commence from Wednesday, 16th September. **Vehicle movement** will only be permitted in the Trade Village all day Wednesday, and between 6am and 7.30am and after 5pm Thursday to Saturday (2.00pm Sunday). Which days you trade is up to you, that is, you do not have to trade for all 4 days. For those of you hiring marquees, these will be erected on Tuesday, 15th September.
3. This year the Trade Village will be located on the strip of grass located between the indoor complex and the cleared land next to the camping block. This means you will be able to peg down your marquees. There are some underground services in the area closest to the indoor, so if you are located on this side weights may be preferable. If you are providing your own marquee you will need to ensure it is sufficiently pegged or weighted down. Hired marquees are provided with weights.
4. **Power:** Can you please let me know at your earliest convenience if you require power for your site.
5. On arrival at the venue please come and see Anita or Nicole in the event office to get your lanyards.
6. This event is not ticketed, however access to the stables is restricted. If you require access to the stables you will need to see the event office for a wrist band.
7. **QSEC Induction:** the venue requires each trade vendor to complete an annual induction. This is done online at: [Site Induction Program \(conceptsafety.com.au\)](https://conceptsafety.com.au). Please complete your induction by September 7th.
8. **Public Liability Insurance:** you are required to have a current Public Liability Insurance Policy. Please email a copy of your Certificate of Currency to Anita Barton, Event Director, by September 11th.
9. **Dogs are not permitted** anywhere at the QSEC Indoor complex, including the grass outside. Please respect this, at is a council requirement, not simply a venue restriction. There are consequences for the venue staff if they are found to be permitting dogs at the Indoor Complex.
10. Camping is not permitted in the Trade Village. There is limited camping on the east side of the indoor or powered camping available at the Caboolture Showgrounds, a 2-minute walk from the Trade Village. Please email brisbanecdievent@gmail.com if you require camping.
11. **Entry and Parking:** Entry will be via the front gate off Tuckeroo Drive via Beerburum Rd (eastern side of the showgrounds). To unload your items in the morning please use the gate next to the carpark entry gate that takes you down the service road. Once unloaded you can park in the QSEC carpark at the northern end of the indoor.

13. **Silent auction:** We are having an online silent auction to help support the event and keep the cost affordable for all riders.
