

Information for Clubs when including the Dressage Queensland Foundation AAOR Series in Events

The Dressage Queensland Foundation Series is automatically included in all 1 Star & 2 Star Events in the Dressage Queensland Calendar. Clubs may also elect to include the Foundation Series in their Non Star Competitive Events

ENTRIES:

WORDING FOR ENTRY SCHEDULES

To be included in All Event Schedules:

Put the below condition in all schedules when running the Foundation Series:

Competitors who enter into the Dressage QLD Foundation AAOR Series competitions MUST fulfil the criteria set down in the Dressage QLD Foundation AAOR Series Qualifying Criteria, as published on the Equestrian QLD Website. The OC reserves the right to accept or reject an entry based on eligibility criteria. Competitors who wish their scores from this event to be considered for DQ Foundation AAOR Series end of the year awards must indicate they meet the criteria at the time of entry. No late requests to be considered for the DQ Foundation Series will be taken after the close of entries

Entries on Nominate:

Nominate have designed a set of questions as part of the Entry Form that will identify Riders as eligible for the Foundation Series. When your event is uploaded ask Nominate to include the Foundation Series questions in your Entry Form. These questions then carry through to your event reports so you are able to identify the Foundation Series Riders for your Draw & Scoring.

If you are not using Nominate for your entries then the following questions must be included in your Entry Schedule:

- Are you currently on the QLD State or National Squad?
- Have you ridden at an Open National Championships in the past 3 years?
- Have you won an Open 2* or above Championship at the level you are entering?
- Do you derive any income, goods or services from horse training, riding or coaching?
- Does the monetary contribution you receive from sponsorship exceed \$1000 per annum?
- Are you a Youth Rider ie: under 22yrs of age?
- Does someone other than the rider own the horse/pony.

Wording for prizes in the Entry Schedule:

For 2 Star Events the following wording for prizes should be used:

Dressage QLD Foundation Series Prizes:

Dressage QLD Foundation Series Riders - Prelim to Inter I - to receive separate Rosettes 1st to 6th to be provided by Dressage QLD. Champions and Reserve Champions will be awarded at

each level. To be eligible for Champion or Reserve at that level Horse/Pony/Rider combinations must compete in both competitions at any one level.

AAOR Rider Prizes:

AAOR Riders Inter II to GP - to receive separate Rosettes 1st to 6th to be provided by Dressage QLD. Champions and Reserve Champions will be awarded for Medium Tour and Big Tour. To be eligible for Champion or Reserve at that level Horse/Pony/Rider combination must compete in both competitions at any one level.

For 1 Star Events the following wording for prizes should be used:

Dressage QLD Foundation Series Prizes:

Dressage QLD Foundation Series Riders - Prelim to Inter I - to receive separate Rosettes 1st to 6th to be provided by Dressage QLD.

AAOR Riders:

AAOR Riders Inter II to GP to receive separate Rosettes 1st to 6th to be provided by Dressage QLD

Non Star Competitive Events:

Dressage Queensland does not provide the rosettes for Non Star Competitive Events. The awarding of Rosettes/Championship prizes or prize money at non-star series events is at the discretion of the individual Organising Committee

1. When not awarding separate ribbons for the Foundation Series riders in Prelim to Inter I:

This is a qualifying event for the Dressage Qld Foundation AAOR Series and only applies to Preliminary to Inter I competitions. Scores from this event will be considered for the DQ Foundation AAOR Series end of year awards. No separate prizes will be given at this event.

2. When awarding separate ribbons for the Foundation Series riders in Prelim to Inter I:

This is a qualifying event for the Dressage Qld Foundation AAOR Series and only applies to Preliminary to Inter I competitions. Scores from this event will be considered for the DQ Foundation AAOR Series end of year awards. Ribbons for 1st to 6th place will be awarded at each level.

SCORING:

Nominate 'Scoreboard' & 'Livescore':

Nominate's scoring system 'Scoreboard' and 'Livescore' have been updated and will now identify Foundation Series Riders in the scoring. An additional Column labelled 'F' has been added to both. If you are using Scoreboard for your event scoring, contact Nominate for instructions on how to include the Foundation Series in your class and championship results.

When not using Nominate's Scoreboard the results for the Foundation Series Riders must be shown in a separate column on your scoresheet.
