

Dressage Queensland State Squads Selection Criteria

For 2022 Squad Selection



Dressage Queensland Squads

- FEI Squad
- Performance Squad
- Young Rider Squad

These squads are designed to be the goal of dressage riders throughout our State and combinations selected onto these squads are the best performing Queensland combinations of the year. Only the most consistently high performing combinations will be selected for the squads.

As well as identifying the best performing combinations in Queensland, the selection of the Queensland Squads has the dual intent of:

- 1. Providing pathways to the National Squads, and
- 2. To promote and develop the Sport within the State of Queensland.

Qualifying Period

For 2022 selection only eligible scores will be taken from 1st July 2020 up to and including the 2021 National Championships. In the event the 2021 National Championships are cancelled, the qualification period will end on October 31st 2021.

General Selection Criteria for All Squads

The following general requirements apply to all three squads: -

In the case where a rider or owner of the horse qualified for squad does not comply with the Equestrian Australia rules, regulations and guidelines, including anti-doping and medication control and yellow card policy (i.e. three yellow cards during the qualifying period) during the squad selection period, selection is not guaranteed and their selection/non-selection will be at the discretion of Dressage Queensland and the Dressage Queensland Selection committee.

- Scores will only be taken from identified squad selection events.
- Selection is for one horse one rider combinations who have attained qualifying scores, and if selected must only be ridden at official competitive dressage competitions/events by the squad rider or their position is forfeit. This restriction does not apply to other disciplines (i.e. Interschool, pony club, eventing, show horse etc)
- Horses and riders must be sound and fit to satisfy competitions standards from the signing of the contract or will be placed on a holding squad.
- Riders must be Australian citizens or permanent residents & MUST be eligible to and declare that they will represent Queensland & Australia (ie hold a current Australian passport).
- Riders MUST be current financial members of Equestrian Queensland and owners of horses must be current financial members of Equestrian Australia.
- A minimum of two qualifying scores MUST be achieved at two separate Queensland qualifying events.
- ONLY scores from defined selection events will be considered.
- No HC, Young Horse or Freestyle scores will be considered.
- Scores used for selection will be unweighted (weighted scores apply ONLY to DQ Trophies).
- Horses and ponies are eligible for selection on all squads.
- Riders (and guardian, if applicable) and owners of horses (where not the rider) must be prepared to sign the Squad Contract by the due date or forfeit their position on the relevant squad.

Holding List for all Squads

- Riders must notify the High Performance Manager in writing (or in the case of Young Riders the Young Rider High Performance Manager) when the horse or rider becomes unfit to compete due to injury or illness as soon as possible with an anticipated recovery time and regularly communicate with the High Performance Manager with progress updates.
- The High Performance Manager in turn liaises with the Chair of Selectors regarding the combinations recuperation progress and expected return to competition standard and also notifies Dressage Queensland of same.
- A combination may remain on the holding list for up to 6 months. If competition is not resumed by this time their place on the squad may be vacated as decided by the Selection Panel and ratified by Dressage Queensland.
- If a combination is placed on the holding list, all squad benefits may be suspended at Dressage Queensland's discretion until the combination is reinstate.

Selection Criteria Dressage Queensland FEI Squad

For 2022 Squad Selection



Purpose

The FEI Squad is for recognition of excellent performances and combinations who have the potential to be selected on to the National High Performance and Recognition Squads. FEI Squad members will act as role models with the intent of raising the standard and profile of dressage in Queensland.

Selection Process

To be eligible for selection combinations must meet the General Selection Criteria and relevant contract.

- Scores considered will be the combination's four (4) best qualifying % equal to and above the minimum qualification %.
- Scores must be achieved from a minimum of three (3) qualifying events (identified below).
- Two scores must be achieved from two separate Queensland-affiliated events.

Qualifying Events

- ALL CDIs (Including National Schedules at CDIs)/National/State championships (any state) at least one (1) result MUST be achieved from one of these events;
- o 2* events:
- Identified Squad Selection events;
- Scores achieved in restricted competitions/events, for example, Young Rider, an AAOR-only competition or a Pony-only competition, are NOT considered qualifying scores, with the exception of the CDI-Y Team or Individual tests or Under 25 Inter II/Grand Prix at CDI events, Australian Adult Amateur Championships and the Queensland Pony State Championships, where one (1) qualifying score can be considered.

- Inter II incl CDI Under 25

Selection Criteria Dressage Queensland Performance Squad



For 2022 Squad Selection

Purpose

The purpose of the Performance Squad is to encourage talented combinations by providing a pathway to National selection. This squad is to develop up-and-coming combinations.

Selection Process

To be eligible for selection combinations must meet the General Selection Criteria and relevant contract

- Scores considered will be the combination's four (4) best qualifying % equal to and over the minimum qualification %.
- Scores must be achieved from a minimum of three (3) qualifying events (identified below).
- Two scores must be achieved from two separate Queensland-affiliated events.

Qualifying Events

- o ALL CDIs (Including National Schedules at CDIs) /National/State championships (any state);
- o 2* events;
- Identified Squad Selection events;
- Scores achieved in restricted competitions, for example, an AAOR-only competition/event or a Pony-only competition/event, are NOT considered qualifying scores, with the exception of the of the CDI-Y Team or Individual tests or Under 25 Inter II/Grand Prix at CDI events, Australian Adult Amateur Championships and the Qld Pony State Championships, where one (1) qualifying score can be considered.

Qualifying Percentages (unweighted)

Selection Criteria Dressage Queensland Youth Rider Squad

For 2022 Squad Selection



Purpose

The purpose of the Youth Rider Squad is to encourage talented young riders by providing a pathway to National selection. This squad is to develop up-and-coming riders.

Further Information

This squad is a rider development squad. If a veterinary certificate is supplied stating that the squad horse is not fit for the squad
activity, that is, Youth Rider camp and nominated Youth Rider/DQ clinics, the Youth Rider may ride a non-squad horse
for these events if they wish.

Selection Process

To be eligible for selection combinations must meet the General Selection Criteria and relevant contract:

- Riders are eligible from the beginning of the year in which they turn 8 years until the end of the year they turn 25 years.
- Scores considered will be the combinations four (4) best qualifying %'s equal to and over the minimum qualification %.
- Scores must be achieved from a minimum of four (4) qualifying events (identified below).
- Two scores must be achieved from two separate Queensland-affiliated events.

Qualifying Events

- ALL CDIs (Including National Schedules at CDIs)/National/State Championships including Youth/Young Rider Championships (any state);
- o 2* events;
- Identified Squad Selection events;
- National or State Interschool Championships (Maximum of only 1 score to count).
