Rod Brown visited Queensland in early July for a Jumping Clinic at Kelecyn Equestrian Centre, sponsored by Eventing Queensland. Squad Riders and Equestrian Queensland members attended, each taking from the clinic something to work on and improve their jumping skills.

Squad riders have commented on how much they enjoyed their time with Rod.

"I really enjoyed my lesson shared with Sandy as it benefited me in so many ways! We were on our way to Quirindi 3DE and I found the simple drills of doing lots of forwards and backs to get my horse responsive very helpful! And also a subtle change in the position of my hands made my horse listen to me more and not hollow coming into a fence which enabled Ace and I to have a very good ride cross country and showjumping in the CCI*." —Emily Rink



"I was lucky enough to have 2 lessons with him on completely different horses as well as spectate for several lessons. SHOWJUMPING PHASE OF A ONE DAY EVENT

The show jumping phase at a One Day Event is similar to an ordinary Jumping Competition. It's main objective is to prove that, the Horse and Athlete are well trained in the specialist discipline of Jumping.


A horse's courage and carefulness are tested by visually challenging fences. You will find there are many variations of fences. Course builders use different jumps to test riders' and horses' ability.

The nature of the course, its length, the speed demanded and the dimensions of the obstacles will be in accordance to the height for the class you have entered.

Below are a few examples of different fences, but there are unlimited combinations of colours, fills, you name it.


Vertical

The vertical is a basic upright fence. There are variations of course, including different "fills", the inclusion of planks, or false ground lines.




Swedish Oxer

This is an oxer, however the poles are crossed over to have a visual impression on the horse. Young or inexperienced horses may find the crossing of the poles visually confusing. In this case, you would possibly choose to ride more forward into the jump to provide your horse with more confidence and encourage him to jump the fence. A Swedish Oxer is measured at the lowest point where the rails "intersect".



Planks


Planks are similar to a vertical however the poles are upright planks on flat cups. Planks are easily knocked down with the slightest rub from the horse. Riders can sometimes become stressed approaching planks as they know how easily they can be tipped off the cups, and hence tense up the horse, and they end up getting a plank down anyway. It's best to remain calm and ignore the fact it is a plank in the first place! Planks can come in variations, such as "wavy planks" which further test the horse's ability to manage visually challenging jumps.



Completing the course in less than the time allowed is not rewarded, but exceeding the time allowed is penalised by one penalty for each commenced second in excess of the time allowed, up to the time limit, which is twice the time allowed. Exceeding the time limit involves elimination.
