EVENTING QUEENSLAND IS ENDING 2015 WITH A BANG

The One Day Event over the weekend of 7 & 8 November will not only be the last One Day Event in Queensland for 2015, but it will also be the Eventing Queensland State Championships.

Thanks to Charlotte Price and the Tamborine Equestrian Group for allowing us to tag the State Championships on to their event.

This event will be the inaugural International event for Tamborine, making it a special event for the Tamborine and Eventing Queensland. CIC1* and CIC2* classes will be open for all eventers in Queensland.

We will then farewell our contingent of riders, wishing them god-speed as they travel to Adelaide to compete in the Australian International Three Day Event. Our riders will join over 100 other riders from around the country, to ride on the purpose built course through the gardens at the centre of South Australia's capital.

The Weekend of Excellence at Kooralbyn over the weekend 28 & 29 November, will be the culmination of activities for 2015. The weekend is an opportunity for many Queensland riders to learn the finer points of competing at One Day Events from some of the most experienced eventers in Queensland. Horse Identification Requirements at FEI competitions (CIC and CCI)

Recently there has been a number of instances at FEI events with riders not bringing their horse's passports and/or EA registration papers. Officials have historically been quite lenient and previously have accepted photocopies or screen shots of the horse's EA papers at 1* and 2* CICs. However, some riders have failed to bring the correct ID documents on numerous occasions, and we have also had cases where riders have arrived at CIC3* competitions expecting the FEI vet to fill in a horse's FEI passport. This has prompted discussion amongst TDs, ground jury members, and members of the national eventing committee to develop a unified approach to this issue.

The FEI consider that there are two levels of events at FEI competitions: CIMs and CIs. CIMs in eventing are CIC/CCI1* and 2*, CIs are CIC/CCI 3*

and above. As a reminder, as per FEI General Regulations (GRs) Article 137:

- "Horses competing at CIMs in a country other than the country of the horse's residency and all horses competing at CIs must, at all times, have an official, valid FEI passport, or a national passport approved by the FEI inserted inside an FEI recognition card."

- "Horses competing at CIMs in their country of residence are not required to have such a passport."

If any horse arrives at a CI (i.e. 3 star or above) without an FEI passport and/or national passport with an FEI recognition card, or its passport is inaccurate, the horse must not be allowed to compete unless the appeal committee (AC) (or ground jury (GJ) if there is no AC), gives its approval. Only in exceptional circumstances may a horse be allowed to compete (GRs Article 137).

Cross Country Course Closure Exemptions

Clubs are reminded the existing period cross country courses are to be closed prior to a competition remains at 4 weeks. However, clubs can request an exemption to this rule for all their competitions in 2015 by submitting the request to Eventing Queensland. Eventing Queensland will need to support the request and forward it to the National Eventing Committee for their endorsement.

National Eventing rules change on the 1 January 2016

National Eventing rules changes will come into effect on 1 January 2016. This is to allow a period for members to familiarise with the changes.
