HELMENT CAMS

The United States Equestrian Federation has released a statement banning riders from using helmet cameras in any USEF licensed or endorsed competitions, this comes following a similar ruling by British Eventing.

The decision is pending completion of an independent expert report on the safety of the cameras.

It is believed the use of a helmet camera and/or it's mounting effected the structural integrity of the helmet worn by Formula 1 legend Michael Schumacher and attributed to the injuries sustained during the skiing accident in 2013 which left him in an induced coma for 6 months.

As of the 12th of November Equestrian Australia are upholding the current rules. BEFORE you ride with a helmet camera at an event you must seek permission from the Technical Delegate.

2014 MEMBERS

To be considered for acceptance on to one of the squads riders must first receive "qualifying" results at particular level of competition. The Elite Squad requires horse and rider combinations to compete at a minimum of 3 events, the Futures squad requires 6 events and the Young Rider squad 7.

To be in the Young Riders Squad riders must be 21yrs or younger.

"Qualifying " results differ for each squad and are as follows:

ELITE SQUAD, complete a;
CIC2* with 60 penalties or less
CCI2* / CIC3* - 70 or less
CCI4* regardless of penalties

FUTURES SQUAD, complete a;
CCI2* with 75 penalties or less
CIC2* - 70 or less
CNC2* - 60 or less
CCI / CIC1* - 55 or less

YOUNG RIDER SQUAD, complete a;
CCI/CIC/CNC 1* with 60 penalties or less
EvA105 – 50 or less
CCI2* - regardless of penalties
