NEW VENUE FOR 2015 QUEENSLAND INTERNATIONAL THREE-DAY EVENT

The 2015 Queensland International Three Day Event will be held at the Noosa Equestrian Centre, Tandur from 3 to 5 October.

Queensland's only International Three Day Event will be directed by former Queensland and Australian eventing champion Brett Cantle with support from equestrian doyen Wayne Roycroft.

The event will again feature the State of Origin challenge between Queensland and New South Wales teams, a dressage master class and a show jumping competition.

BUT WAIT ... THERE'S MORE ...

This year the Queensland International Three Day Event will be held in conjunction with the Eventing Queensland State Championships.

The existing course is being upgraded to Three Star in preparation for event.

Eventing Queensland is pleased to partner with the Queensland International Three Day Event Committee and Noosa Equestrian Centre to ensure this year's State Championships will be an event to remember.

2015 Equestrian Australia National Rules for Eventing

The 2015 rule book is available on the Equestrian Australia website (www.equestrian.org.au). Download the mark-up version to quickly identify what's new. Better still, give the full book the once over, to keep up-to-date with all the rules.

Medical Information

The 2015 Eventing Rules now stipulate, riders only need to wear a Medical Armband if they have a medical condition. Instead all riders need to provide Next of Kin information to the event organisers before the Cross Country Phase. This information is provided to the Medical Responders to comply with the rule change. The Next of Kin information should be a person the Medical Responders can contact, someone at the grounds is preferable. This person should also have knowledge of anything that might be important when the Medical Responders are assisting you at an event.

Please make sure this information is up-to-date and fully completed when you enter a competition on the Nominate website, so the event organisers can use the information for the Medical Responders.

For Your Information

The 2015 National Eventing rule is available only. Below are EXCERPTS of SOME of the updates. Please read the entire rule to ensure you have a full understanding. As always if you are unsure about a rule, officials and Eventing Queensland are here to help.

Article 523.1 Medical Information

To ensure that vital information is available to first aid or medical personnel in case of emergency, athletes must comply with the following:

- a) Providing valid contact information is mandatory for all Athletes.
- b) Athletes with medical condition that may be relevant in the case of a medical emergency are responsible at every event when riding for wearing a medical data carrier.

Article 505.3.4 CNC/CCN Prize Money

In all Official Events, including those confined to Juniors, prizes will be awarded to horses according to their placings and the number of starters in the class.

- A minimum of one prize shall be awarded for every 4 competitors.
- A minimum of three prizes must be offered in every class.
- The first three prizes must be cash, with third prize not being less than the entry fee.
- At EvA80 and EvA95, prize money is optional.
- Organisers may award additional prizes lower than the scale.

NB: A starter is one which competed (i.e. started) in the dressage test.

Article 538.1 & 538.2.1

Whilst riding in Competition, Athletes must ensure that long hair is tied and neat.

Article 522

Proof of MERs gained at EvA105 and below in order to cancel a reverse qualification are required to be sent to the state branch/representative by the rider.

EQ Biosecurity Policy Statement

Equestrian Queensland is the peak body for horse sports in Queensland and aims to conduct the safest equestrian events possible for all involved including competitors, horses, event organizers, volunteers and visitors.

Equestrian Queensland and our sport affiliates take biosecurity seriously and have measures in place to mitigate the risk of infectious diseases and pests. Best practice biosecurity will be achieved through: Biosecurity Plans and Biosecurity Contingency plans for all events conducted by Equestrian Queensland and our sport affiliates

Horse Health Declaration (HHD) for all events conducted Equestrian Queensland and our sports affiliates Promoting the Property Identification Code (PIC) of horse's origin be included on the HHD.

Eventing Queenland Random Teams

With two events under our belts, the 2015 Eventing Queensland Teams competitions has proved to be a popular addition to our events.

At the close of entries one horse for every rider entered in a competitive class is placed on a team consisting of three or four riders, randomly selected by computer. At the end of the event the three lowest penalties of the team riders are tallied and the team with the lowest penalties is declared the winner. A team of three is competitive and may beat a team of four.

Where possible each team will have an Eventing Queensland Squad Rider or experienced eventer to give those less experienced competitors another point of contact should they be unsure of anything.

Riders are encouraged to seek out and support the other members of their team throughout the event.

At each of the events so far this year, two different teams have taken home the prize money. Team WARREGO on 165.1 penalties were the conquerors at the Tamborine event, and Team JAMES on 150.2 penalties were victors at Warwick.

Eventing Queensland Awards

The movement of EvA95 (Preliminary) to now be considered an 'above the line' or official class has prompted Eventing Queensland to undertake a review of the Award Criteria. Awards that have been generously donated to the Eventing Community in Queensland have been kept the same to respect the wishes of the donating families. Other awards have been updated to make them more relevant for the present class structure. The weighting being applied to the award criteria will bring Queensland into line with other states.

As we start this new year of competitions we look forward to calculating the results, and recognising the achievements of our riders.

QUEENSLAND HORSE AND RIDER OF THE YEAR

To the Queensland Horse and Senior Rider combination who has accrued the highest points at Official Events competing in One, Two, Three and Four Star Classes, in Queensland and Interstate during the season.

Providing the result can be classified as a Minimum Eligibility Requirement, a weighting will be applied to the results as per Annex K of the National Eventing Rules.

MARK MYERS MEMORIAL QUEENSLAND SENIOR RIDER OF THE YEAR

To the Queensland Senior Rider who accrues the highest points at Official Events competing in Star Classes, in Queensland during the season. Providing the result can be classified as a Minimum Eligibility Requirement, a weighting will be applied to the results as per Annex K of the National Eventing Rules.

MARK MYERS MEMORIAL QUEENSLAND JUNIOR RIDER OF THE YEAR

To the Queensland Junior Rider who accrues the highest points at Official Events competing in Star Classes, in Queensland during the season. Providing the result can be classified as a Minimum Eligibility Requirement, a weighting will be applied to the results as per Annex K of the National Eventing Rules.

KYLIE WILMEN MEMORIAL TROPHY

To the Queensland Horse and Junior Rider combination who has accrued the highest points at Official Events competing in One and Two Star Classes, in Queensland and Interstate during the season. Points will be awarded based on Junior Classes or in a mixed class the junior riders within the class.

Providing the result can be classified as a Minimum Eligibility Requirement, a weighting will be applied to the results as per Annex K of the National Eventing Rules.

INTERNATIONAL RIDER OF THE YEAR

To the Queensland Rider who has competed at International level events (CIC and CCI classes) in Queensland and other states and accrued the highest points throughout the season.

Providing the result can be classified as a Minimum Eligibility Requirement, a weighting will be applied to the results as per Annex K of the National Eventing Rules.

NATIONAL HORSE AND RIDER OF THE YEAR
