Starts per day:

At all times when considering participating in multiple disciplines and/or multiple classes, horse and rider welfare must be paramount.

No horse is to undertake more than three competitive starts per day across disciplines (see below).

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – MUST READ:

1. Numbers for all **classes will be capped** - preference will be given to DD & SWQ region members.
2. **IQ riders from other IQ regions** will automatically be placed on a waiting list. Preference is given to riders within the DDSWQ region. In the case of oversubscription, riders NOT accepted to compete will be notified by e-mail within 7 days of close of entries and will be fully refunded. Riders accepted will ride HC. This means they are not eligible for ribbons, trophies, or team prizes. Rider scores, however, may still be used as qualifiers for State Championships.
3. **Prizes:** Sashes, prizes and trophies for Champions, Place Ribbons to 6th place. Champion Teams: Ribbons to 4th place.
4. **Unmounted presentations** will be held at the conclusion of each day's event. It is compulsory for all riders from the DDSWQ Region to attend. **If you are required to leave early for any reason, you MUST speak to a member of the Organising Committee to gain approval.**
5. **Helper's roster:** Helper's Roster will be available on SignUp.com. Each helper is required to report to the office at least 15 minutes prior to their allotted starting time to sign in. The draw will be located on Nominate a few days prior to the event as well as emailed to competitors. Interschool Queensland operates under a strict **"NO HELPER-NO RIDE-NO STATE QUALIFIER" policy**. SignUp will be used so you are able to choose your helper jobs for this event. The link for the Sign Up program will be emailed through to competitors when the draws are available. Please ensure you log in and select your jobs. If you do not choose your job yourself, jobs will be allocated for you. Information on how to sign in for your job will be posted in the days prior to the event and on the Stack Team app. **If a helper or substitute does not present on the day, the rider's scores will be withheld, and the parents will be required to make an application to Interschool Qld within 7 days of the event, requesting that the scores be able to be used as a qualifying score, with an explanation as to why the helper's job was not fulfilled. It is up to Equestrian Qld then if the scores may be qualifiers. The rider's scores at the event will remain as HC scores. This will be strictly adhered to.**
6. It is a condition of entry that each rider should provide a helper for each class you compete in during the event. In DD & SWQ region, we cap at 3 helper jobs per family.
If, however there is a shortage of volunteers to effectively run the event, families may be asked to complete extra volunteer roles.
7. **Marshalling/Gear Check:**
 - All Show Jumping (inc. CT jumping) and Show Horse competitors must present to the marshalling / gear check point at least 15 min prior to their ride time in each and every class. While a gear check is undertaken, it is the responsibility of the competitor and/or parents to ensure their gear/equipment complies with the discipline rules.
 - For Dressage, under the current EA Dressage rules, every dressage horse and rider combination must attend a compulsory gear check for every test they ride **AFTER each test**. Dressage riders will need to ensure they present to the gear check steward **AFTER** each test for a gear check. *We strongly encourage all Dressage riders to request a pre-test visual check to ensure they have appropriate gear, but this does not replace the post-test official gear check.*
8. **Membership.** All schools represented must be current members of EQ. Riders must be financial members and horses must be registered as per the IQ Handbook by close of entries.
9. **HORSE numbers.** Riders **MUST** have their allocated numbers attached to the saddlecloth or bridle on **both sides. You must also have your numbers on your halter when out of the stables (e.g. a key tag with the numbers on both sides).** These numbers will be supplied with the released draws.
10. All **dogs to be on a leash at all times.** No dogs allowed in competition, warm up or stable areas.
11. Electric Scooters are banned at Toowoomba Showgrounds.
12. **Scratchings- Before the event,** please e-mail all scratchings immediately to ddswqregionals@gmail.com as soon as possible to facilitate the smooth running of this event. **You must also scratch via NOMINATE. Scratching is not considered official until notification has been received from Nominate.**
During the event, please text relevant discipline convenors and email ddswqregionals@gmail.com.
Entry fees will not be refunded after the close of entries. The non-refundable admin fee will apply to all refunds. Exemptions based on veterinary/medical grounds will be at the sole discretion of the organising committee and will require documentary evidence within 7 days of the event. This is your responsibility, and the OC will not follow up.

13. **Once the draws have been published, there will be no change in classes, class times, class order, or heights unless prior approval from the OC has been sought. If so, the horse and rider combination may be required to ride HC. After the close of entries, any changes that need to be made to entries will incur a \$20.00 admin fee.**
14. Riders may **substitute** an alternative horse up until the start of competition for the day providing the request is accompanied by a veterinary certificate. The horse must also have the appropriate EQ/EA registration.
15. No rider may be substituted for another.
16. In the event of **cancellation of the competition** or part thereof, due to any circumstances beyond the control of the relevant organising committee, entry fees will be refunded less than 30% to help defray administration costs.
17. **Stabling and camping.** Stables will be pre-allocated, no changing of locations is permitted. Stables must be left clean. Riders will be held responsible for making sure their stables are left clean. All horses that enter the ground **MUST** fill out the Horse Health Declaration & hand it to the event office before riding on day of arrival. Horses not nominated for the competition will not be allowed entry to the grounds. There is to be no stabling or lodging of horses in areas outside the designated stabling complex e.g. no electric tape or portable yards.
18. **Competition schedule.** The competition times in the published schedule are correct at the time of publication and should be taken as a guide for competitors only. Rings may run early due to scratchings - please be attentive to announcements to this effect on the day. Riders who do not ride at their designated time without prior approval from the OC may face elimination. Please advise Office or Gear Check if the rider is held up in another ring.
19. **Draws.** Draws will be available on Nominate prior to the event. Latest versions of the draws will be posted to Stack Team App on the morning of that competition. You must check daily due to scratchings. Any errors must be advised to the relevant discipline convenor's email asap **before the event commences.**
20. **Disputes.** No competitors/parents or coaches are to directly approach any judges, stewards, course builders or any other officials or volunteers with disputes, complaints or queries. Any disputes, complaints or queries during the competition must be lodged in writing with the OC through the School Convenor with a fee of \$100 within 30 minutes after the happening which gave rise to the objection. These will be referred to the Technical Delegate/Ground Jury of the day. The decision of the Technical Delegate/Ground Jury will be final and may not be appealed.
21. **Ground Jury.** This will be made up of the judges of each discipline.
22. **Behaviour.** The EA Code of Conduct must be strictly adhered to by all competitors and their parents/guardians during this event. They can be found in the current IQ Handbook. Those who fail to do so, risk elimination from the competition. Being a school-based event, all competitors must obey school rules and competition etiquette when representing their school and whilst on competition grounds. Damage to any third party by anyone at the competition will be the responsibility of the adult involved or the parents/guardians of those who cause any damage.
23. **Vehicles other than cars and trucks.** IQ, EQ and the Darling Downs & South West Qld Regional Event Sub-Committee accept no responsibility in relation to the use of motorized vehicles on the grounds over the course of the competition. Motor bikes, four wheelers, trikes, scooters, bicycles or other such vehicles will not be permitted on the grounds where horses are being worked or competed and it is the responsibility of parents and guardians to enforce this ruling. Users of such vehicles risk having them banned or expelled from the grounds if they are being used in a manner which is deemed dangerous or irresponsible by the OC.
24. **DPI/Biosecurity/PIC Number.** Competitors are responsible for checking with the DPI regarding the requirement for spraying of horses for ticks. A Horse Health declaration **MUST** be filled out for every horse on the ground – please leave at the event office. You are required to supply your PIC number. Any horses showing signs of ill health must be reported directly to Tracey Sexton on 0438 234 815. Horses may be isolated until seen by a vet and any expense incurred will be the responsibility of the owner.
25. **Medication Control.** Random swabbing of horses may occur to ensure that all horses are competing under the national EA and FEI competition rules without being influenced by prohibited substances. Please ensure that you have all horses' registration papers available. More information can be found at:

26. **Saddlery and equipment** – as per current IQ Handbook for each discipline.

27. **General Dress for riders** – as per current IQ Handbook. Riders are expected to be present in their official school equestrian uniforms for presentations.
28. **Horses.** Stallions are not eligible to enter. Horse abuse in any form will not be tolerated. If horse abuse is determined, the athlete will be disqualified from the competition. The sighting of blood on the horse during a competition phase can entail elimination and/or investigation by the Ground Jury/Technical Delegate based upon the Sport Rules of the discipline involved.
29. **Soundness & Safety.** The Judges are required to satisfy themselves regarding soundness of all horses and therefore have the authority to stop an unsound horse during the competition or from competing – any disputes in this area will be considered by the ground jury on the day and/or the Technical Delegate.
30. **Teams.** There will be two divisions, Primary and Secondary. All classes will count toward team points. For prizes/ribbons to be awarded there must be a minimum of three teams in a division. The OC, at their discretion, reserves the right to award team ribbons and prizes where less than three teams are present in the primary division. Rules for the Teams competition will be as per the teams scoring rules for the IQ State Championships as listed in the current IQ Handbook.
31. **General disclaimer.** Neither the OC, the Darling Downs & South-West Qld Regional Event Sub-Committee, IQ, EQ, nor the Toowoomba Regional Council (Toowoomba Show Grounds) accepts any liability for any accident, injury, illness to riders, spectators, horses, grounds or any other persons or property whatsoever in consideration of entries being accepted. No entries will be accepted unless riders and parents have noted the Acknowledgement and Indemnity Waiver (provided on Nominate) and accepted that they have read and agreed to the EA Code of Conduct.
32. **Strictly Out of Bounds:** ALL Cross-country practice fences and ALL Cross-Country areas are not to be entered.
33. **Photography consent.**

By participating in this event, you are consenting to your child/children being photographed or filmed. Equestrian Queensland may use these images for promotional use of the Interschool program, this includes but is not limited to, use on the Equestrian Queensland website, marketing material and in all forms of media. I understand photos in which my child/children appear may be submitted to Equestrian Queensland, partners and stakeholders who may also use these images for the purpose of promoting their association with Equestrian Queensland.
34. **Champions & Tied Scores** for all disciplines will be decided as per the current IQ Handbook.
35. **Best all-round riders – Primary & Secondary.** The Summers Family Trophy (Secondary) and The Sailor Trophy (Primary – donated by the Coggan family), will be awarded to the rider Primary and Secondary with the best all round result from the one horse/rider combination across all 4 disciplines. To be eligible for this award, riders must enter the 4 disciplines on the one horse at official level, not training heights. The winner will be the rider with the highest aggregate IQ points. The Webb Family Trophy is awarded to the Champion School Team consisting of a minimum 3 riders and maximum of 6 riders. Please note: 2 riders do not make up a team.
36. **Helmet Tagging.** It is a requirement for all helmets to be tagged before entering the competition ring. Officials at our Regional event will be on the grounds to do this. Please note this is mandatory for every discipline.
37. The organising committees have the right to cancel any class or event, divide any class, alter advertised times, refuse any entry, transfer athletes between sections of a class as they see fit.
38. **Photographers:** Only those photographers engaged by the OC can attend the event and take photos for the purposes of distribution (financial or otherwise).

- Riders may enter two horses in the same or different classes but only the higher scoring horse's points will be eligible for team placings.
- Regarding the three start per day rule, Combined Training is considered as two competitive starts.
- Riders in CT80 classes and below may carry a whip when entering the space around the arena and during the dressage test. A whip no longer than 120cm including lash, or a crop no longer than 75cm and not weighted at the end, is allowed.
- Callers allowed for all riders.
- The wearing of gloves in the dressage phase is optional.
- The jumping phase is run in reverse order. This means that riders with the most penalties will jump first and riders with the least penalties will jump last.
- NO MOBILE PHONES TO BE USED IN WARM UP. EARPHONES MAY BE USED HOWEVER ONLY ONE EARPIECE CAN BE USED IN THE COMPETITION WARM UP

- Each class will have a timed draw and all riders will complete an individual workout for each phase.
- Rider/horse combination may compete in **one** class only, you must choose between Show Horse or Show Hunter.
- Riders must complete all phases in the class on the same horse.
- Riders may enter a max of 2 horses but only the higher scoring horse's points will be eligible for team placings.
- Horse/Rider number must be always displayed in each phase.
- Ribbons will be awarded for led, rider and ridden classes and Championship.
- Check the IQ Handbook for which classes are available at States & Nationals.
- **Walk Trot Class** – These classes are for children in prep to year 3 on lead line only. These classes are designed to give riders on lead experience.
- Please be aware as per EA rules Draw reins & similar training devices are not to be used for warming up.

- Horses may not compete below their graded level (if an official dressage grading applies).
- Riders are permitted to enter two consecutive levels per horse.
- If a rider competes two horses at the same level, then only the higher scoring horse's points will be eligible for team placings.
- Each dressage test is considered 1 start ie: 1.2 is one start, 1.3 is one start.
- Callers are permitted in classes up to and including Advanced.
- Gloves are compulsory for all classes.
- Whips are permitted (not exceeding 1.2m, including tassel for horses and 1.0m for ponies)
- Whips are not permitted in FEI classes.
- Only snaffle bits are allowed unless competing at Medium or above.
- Use of spurs as per Dressage Discipline Rules.
- Gear Check is done at the Completion of each test. Please report back to the Marshalling Tent.
- Elimination will occur if Gear Check is not completed.
- Changes to timetable may occur based on entry numbers and at the discretion of the OC.
- The ride time (as per the draw) is the time riders report to the dressage judge, not to marshalling. Riders should report to marshalling 15 minutes before their ride time. Riders must ride to time and in the order as per the draw.
- Bridle or saddle pad numbers must be worn on both sides of the horse and are the allocated 3-digit competition number. State-issued dressage bridle numbers used in official competitions are not to be used.
- The Dressage competition is run in accordance with the current Interschool QLD Handbook and EA National Dressage Rules (Updated 1/1/26).
- It is the rider's responsibility to be familiar with these rules and abide by the rulings.
- **Secondary Intermediate** is defined as those riders enrolled in grades 7, 8, 9 in the current year.
- **Secondary Senior** divisions are for those riders enrolled in grades 10, 11, 12 in the current year.

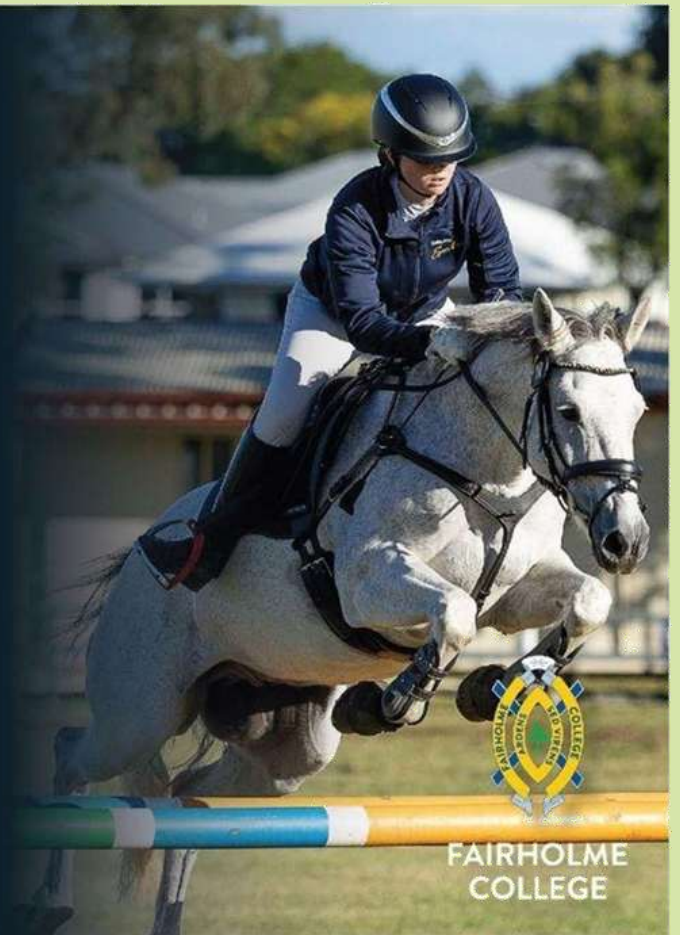

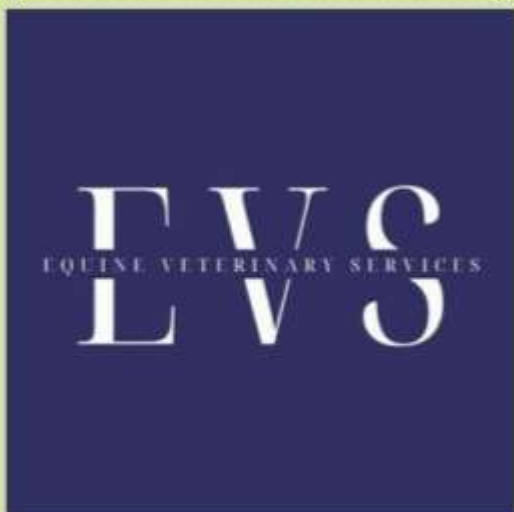
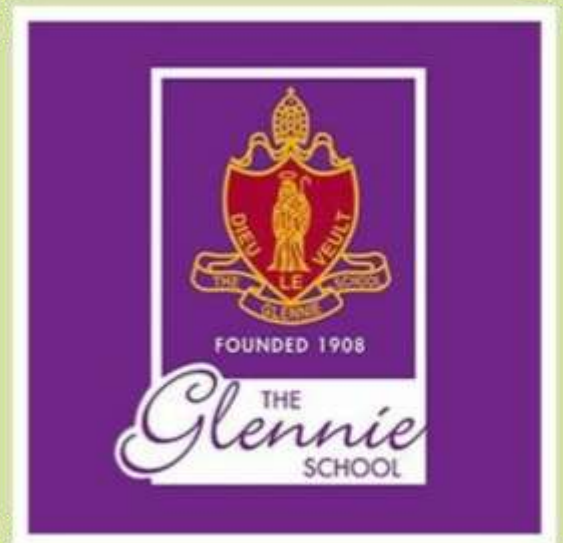
