



# **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

# 1. Purpose

The Interschool Queensland (IQ) Regional Sub-Committees (hereafter referred to as "Sub-Committees") are established to support the objectives of the Interschool Queensland Sport Committee and Equestrian Queensland (EQ).

As extensions of the IQ Sport Committee, the Sub-Committees provide regional leadership, coordination, and representation to ensure the growth, development, and sustainability of interschool equestrian sport across Queensland.

#### 2. Term

- Sub-Committees are appointed for a twelve (12) month term and re-appointed each year via an expression of interest process, subject to review by IQ.
- Membership is reviewed annually to ensure representation reflects the needs of the region.
- Members may be re-appointed following the conclusion of their term, subject to IQ approval.
- All sub-committee members must attend a Sport Committee induction each year.

# 3. Governance and Accountability

- All IQ Regional Sub-Committees are an extension of the IQ Sport Committee.
- Accordingly, the same requirements and standards that apply to members of the Sport Committee also apply to Sub-Committee members.
- Sub-Committees are accountable to the IQ Sport Committee and, ultimately, to the **EQ Board**.

## 4. Objectives

The objectives of the Sub-Committees are to:

- Plan, organise, and deliver the annual Regional Championships within their region to a high standard.
- **Provide a safe, fair, and inclusive competition environment** that complies with sport-specific rules, organisational policies, and risk management requirements.
- **Promote participation and engagement** through effective communication, marketing, and community outreach.
- **Foster strong relationships with stakeholders**, including sponsors, volunteers, schools, and the wider equestrian community.
- Support the strategic direction of Interschool Queensland by providing advice and recommendations to the IQ Sport Committee on regional matters.

#### 5. Functions

The Sub-Committees are responsible for:

# **Event Planning & Delivery**

- Planning and delivering the annual Regional Championships within their region.
- Managing competition logistics, including entries, scheduling, stabling, technical equipment, catering, and facilities.
- Overseeing event set-up and pack-down, ensuring venues are safe, accessible, and functional.

# **Compliance & Risk Management**

- Ensuring all events comply with sport-specific rules, organisational policies, and safety standards.
- Implementing risk management requirements (e.g. child safety, concussion protocols, incident reporting, emergency procedures).
- Maintaining horse and rider welfare as the highest priority.

# Sponsorship, Fundraising & Finance

- Coordinating sponsorships and fundraising initiatives to support the Regional Championships.
- Managing sponsorship agreements, including signage, presentations, public acknowledgements, and digital promotion.
- Ensuring financial accountability by managing budgets and providing reports as required.

# **Marketing & Communications**

- Coordinating event communications, including programs, schedules, catalogues, website updates, and social media.
- Promoting the Championships through member communications, media releases, and community engagement.
- Managing branding to ensure consistency with EA, EQ and IQ guidelines.

# **Volunteers & Stakeholder Engagement**

- Recruiting, briefing, and allocating roles to volunteers to ensure smooth event delivery.
- Providing recognition and support to volunteers and officials.
- Representing the organisation professionally in dealings with sponsors, partners, schools, and the public.

# **Reporting & Regional Feedback**

- Providing post-event reports, advice, and recommendations to the IQ Sport Committee on regional matters.
- Identifying opportunities for improvement in future events.

# 7. Membership & Appointment

- Each year, Interschool Queensland opens Expressions of Interest (EOIs) for membership of Regional Sub-Committees.
- Members are appointed through this process in line with EQ's Sport Committee Membership Policy.
- Sub-Committee membership should reflect a balance of skills, experience, and school representation.
- Each Sub-Committee should appoint a **Chairperson**, **Secretary**, and **Treasurer** (if applicable) to support effective governance.

# 8. Meetings & Reporting

- Sub-Committees should meet monthly, or as required.
- Minutes or Summary of Actions/Outcomes must be recorded and provided to the IQ Sport Committee.
- A budget must be provided to the IQ Sport Committee.
- A debrief report summarising regional championships successes and challenges must be submitted to the IQ Sport Committee.

# 9. Review of Terms of Reference

These Terms of Reference will be reviewed by the IQ Sport Committee every **two years**, or earlier if required, to ensure they remain current and effective.
