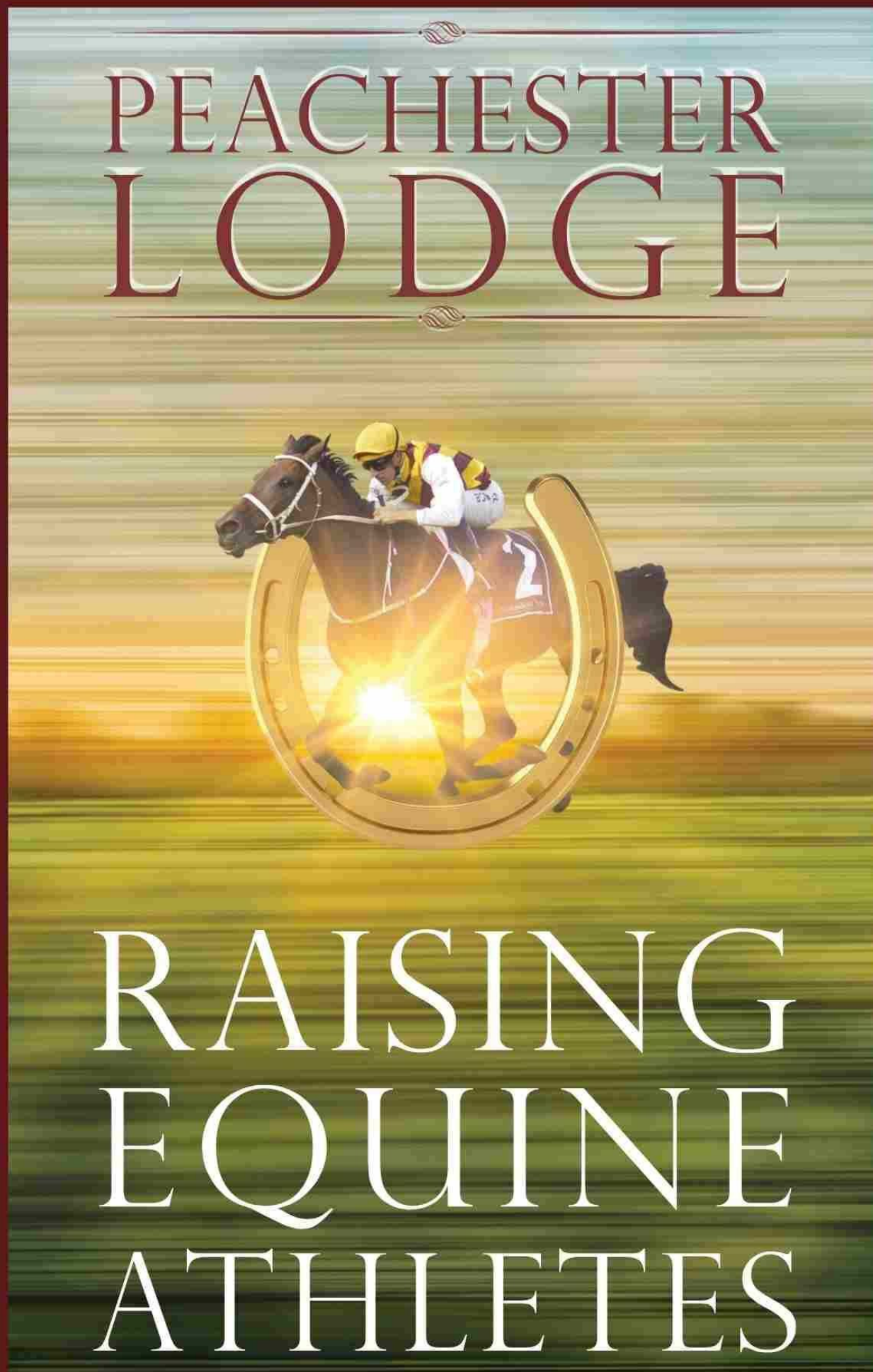

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRIES

- All entries are to be made via Equipe
- **Entries open:** 10th September 2025
- **Entries close:** 1st October 2025
- A \$25 Ambulance levy and a \$25 administration fee will be charged per rider

Wait List

- Wait lists will be created for classes if oversubscribed, and competitors will be notified of acceptance once nominations are finalised
- Entries will be accepted once your payment has been processed
- Equestrian Australia Waivers must be signed for your entry to be accepted – form on Equipe

Number of Starts

- Maximum of two starts per horse for the 1st and 2nd days
- ONE START ONLY on Monday
- Open and TSHA classes will be run together but judged separately. Horse can be entered either as Open or TSHA - not both
- Horses must be entered in the correct class from the beginning of competition - no switching between TSHA and Open
- A horse is able to compete in two different Championship qualifiers but can only compete in one final (or championship), if qualified for more than one, competitor must let the office know which final the horse will compete in so that another horse can be given the opportunity to start in final in which the horse is being withdrawn.
- Each rider is permitted no more than 3 entries in one class

Refunds

- Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$25 administration fee
- No refund after close of entries

CAMPING & STABLE / YARD BOOKINGS

Camping and stable bookings are to be made online via Equipe.

SCRATCHINGS

Notice of scratchings must be completed on Equipe.

DRAWS / RESULTS

- Draws will be posted on Equipe and the events will run to draw order.
- Results will be live on Equipe.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

RULES & REGULATIONS

- This event is run under Equestrian Australia rules and regulations
- The Organising Committee reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend the program or any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit
- All riders must wear helmets that comply with EA Helmet standards

EA Membership and Horse Registration

- All riders and owners must be current financial members of Equestrian Australia (EA)
- When competing below 1.05m, riders must have EA participant or competitor membership and horses must be EA base registered
- When competing in 1.05m and above, riders must have EA competitor membership and horses must be EA full life registered and have a current jumping competition licence.

Presentations

Riders **MUST** present at presentation mounted (stallions may be substituted for presentation) or prizemoney will be forfeited

CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS

- The top 20 placed horses for each Championship will be selected via the following system:
 - The overall winner of a qualifying class will receive the same number of points as horses in the class e.g. If there are 50 horses in the class, the winner will receive 50 points, 2nd place 49 and so on down to 1 point for the last horse. If a horse and rider is eliminated or retires, no points are allocated
- The draw for the final will be the reverse of points gained e.g. the horse with the most points will go last in the draw for the final
- The qualifying round and final must be the same horse and rider combination

CLASS ELIGIBILITY

- **Children:** An Athlete may compete in Children's classes from the calendar year they turn 10 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14 years old.
- **Juniors:** Athletes can take part in Competitions for Juniors from the calendar year they turn 12 until the end of the calendar year, in which they reach the age of 18 years
- **Young Riders:** Athletes may take part in Competitions and Championships for Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 21.
- **Amateur Rider:** Athletes who:
 - Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing
 - In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying competition or in a 5* 3 day event/ 4* 3 day event prior to 2021.
 - Must not have competed in section 1 or 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years
 - Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that event.
 - Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a Horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that event

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

CLASS ELIGIBILITY CONTINUED

Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association (TSHA) Terms & Conditions

- To be eligible to enter TSHA classes your horse must be registered with a registered Thoroughbred Stud Book, have a microchip number and a TSHA competition license.
- TSHA competition licenses can be purchased on Global Entries by logging in and going to the 'Manage Horses' page.
- Open and TSHA classes will be run together but judged separately. Horse can be entered either as Open or TSHA - not both.
- Horses must be entered in the correct class from the beginning of competition - no switching between TSHA and Open.

BIOSECURITY, HEALTH & SAFETY

Other Animals

- No animals other than competition horses are permitted in or around the stable, warm up or competition areas.
- All other animals must be restrained and kept within the camping area.
- There is a full fenced off leash dog park located at the southern end of the campground.

Scooters and Bikes

- Not to be used in or near any competition or warm up areas or stable areas
- Helmets must be worn
- Any scooter or bike that is left unattended will be confiscated

Prams, strollers and the protection of young children

- There are to be no prams, strollers or young children in any warm up areas during the competition.

Horse Health Declarations

- Horse Health Declarations (HHD) must be supplied on arrival or emailed prior to competing.
