Young Rider Squad

Open to athletes from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 21

Junior Squad

Open to athletes until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 18 years

Qualifying Performances

<u>Junior Squad</u> – any class run at an EA endorsed event which has a <u>published start</u> <u>height</u> of 120cm or more. Results gained at Interschool competitions in the 120cm class may be included.

<u>Young Rider Squad</u> – any class run at an EA endorsed event which has a <u>published</u> <u>start height</u> of 130cm or more.

The performance must have eight faults or less to qualify.

Squad Performance cards (with no less than 6 results) are to be submitted via the platform utilised.
