



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Please note that there will be NO LATE ENTRIES OR CHANGES after 7 pm on Thursday 3rd September 2020.
- We will not be accepting any late entries or changes on the day and neither will our marshals.
- If you are not the named rider in the draw you will not be allowed into the arena.
- Please log onto Global to check and change your entries before 7 pm on Thursday 3rd September 2020.
- Please also see the COVID-19 Plan for this event.
- Please ensure you have read the Plan in advance of the competition. The Plan must be read and agreed to by everyone who intends to enter the grounds.
- Due to the COVID-19 restriction of only 500 people allowed onto the grounds and to ensure all those who have entered can ride, we are very sorry but due to the restrictions we must apply additional entry conditions as follows:
- You must be a rider, parent, carer, groom or support person to enter the grounds.
- No spectators are permitted (this includes owner spectators).
- Please limit the number of people attending with you to no more than 1 per rider if at all possible and for everyone's benefit.
- With the government restrictions that are in place at this time Jumping Qld appreciates your cooperation and understanding at this time
- Entries will open on Global Entries on-line at 7pm on Monday 17th August 2020
- All ENTRIES, STABLES, CAMPING and AMBULANCE, must be lodged by the 24th August 2020 on Global Entries by 9pm
- All riders competing at the event will be expected to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry
- REFUNDS AFTER CLOSE OF ENTRIES will be considered on a case by case basis less the Admin Fee
- The Organising Committee reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend the program or any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.
- Stabling will be at \$20 per night per horse + \$25 stable bond which will be refunded if the stables are left in a clean and tidy state
- A limited number of yards built in the cattle sheds will be available for \$20 per night per horse + \$25 stable bond which will be refunded if the stables are left in a clean and tidy state
- Build your own yards are permitted for the cost of \$40 per horse for the event
- No Electric Fences allowed
- Camping \$20 per night
- \$25 per rider Ambulance levy
- \$15 Covid Compliance Fee
- A \$20 administration fee will be charged on each rider's nominations
- Horses are allowed ONE START PER DAY (not one start in each ring!)
- All placegetters MUST present at presentations mounted (stallions may be substituted with another horse for presentations), or prizemoney is forfeited
- All riders and owners must be financial members of the EA to compete in official classes, and all horses competing in official classes must hold current EA registration and performance cards. Riders may be required to present horse registration/performance cards upon request of the committee.
- DRESS All riders to be dressed according to the FEI requirements and those attired incorrectly will not be allowed to start.
- Australian Helmet standards will apply
- All riders must wear riding boots and an approved helmet at all times while mounted
- SWABBING: The Organising Committee reserves the right to swab horses.
 Random swabbing of horses may be conducted in any class.
 Horses chosen for swabbing must proceed directly to the swabbing box immediately after the presentation.

INFORMATION FOR THE THOROUGBRED SPORT HORSE COMPETITOR

Who is eligible?

To be eligible for TSHA classes your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book. No part bred thoroughbreds will be eligible.

To compete in the thoroughbred only classes you must purchase a competition licence with the TSHA through Global Entries Online.

How do I obtain my licence?

- The licence can be obtained by logging into www.globalentriesonline.com.au
- Go to the 'Manage Horses" page
- Click on the "TSHA licence" button and fill in the details
- If you don't already have an account with Global Entries it is simple to create one and then follow the instructions above.

You must provide a microchip number. If this is not possible please provide your horse's race name and/or their breeding (dam and sire). If you are having trouble finding the information please send us an email and we can help you info@thoroughbredsporthorse.com.au

The information provided to us via your licence is very important. This data will go towards the statistics for rehoming and repurposing racehorses and is a key reason for the industry sponsorship.

Licence Information

The cost of the licence is \$55 per year.

Your licence runs for a full calendar year from the date you pay for your licence which means every horse gets 365 days of value for money. The TSHA is a not-for-profit organisation and the licence fees collected go towards the costs of running the TSHA. Any left-over funds are channelled back into prize money and rugs, ribbons, garlands, etc. The licence fee is for competition purposes only and is not proof of ownership.

Any prize money will be paid to the winning rider.

Connections of the horse must organise the prize money split, if any, between themselves.

Any horses and riders competing in the TSHA Thoroughbred classes 1.05m and over must also hold EA registration.

*** Note regarding entering thoroughbred classes at popular shows where entries fill up very quickly *******

We recommend you purchase your TSHA competition licence before entries to popular shows open so that you don't miss out/have problems entering classes.

Sport / Rider Development Funding EQ provided \$52,553 to Affiliated Clubs and EQ Sport Committees to support member development, growth & participation across all disciplines through rider development clinics or protocol days

High Performance Funding

EQ together with EA High Performance Funding provided \$23,225 to support the development of elite athletes through EQ Sport Committee high performance programs

Coaches and Officials Education Funding EQ provided \$18,530 to support the development of accredited EA Coaches and Officials by providing funds to assist with travel expenses associated with attending EA/FEI courses
