

Funding Distribution



Sport Development / Rider Development

EQ provided \$32,085 to affiliated Clubs and EQ Sport Committees to support member development, growth & participation across all disciplines through rider development clinics or protocol days. EQ also provided \$2,400 to regional affiliated Clubs to assist with Judges travelling expenses to support development in Dressage, Eventing and Jumping.

A further \$5,050 was provided for Junior Rider Development and Education through the delivery of the EQ/IQ EquiSkills Program (Introductory Horse Management and Introductory Riding Certificates).



Officials Education

EQ provided \$18,880 to support the development of EA accredited Officials by providing funds to assist with the delivery of accreditation courses and funds to assist with travel expenses associated with officials attending EA/FEI courses.



Coaching Education

EQ provided \$19,405 to support the growth and development of EA Coaches, SSTA's and Coach Educators through the delivery of EA accreditation courses and assessment opportunities such as the EQ Coaching Intensive Clinic.



High Performance

EQ provided \$13,725 to support the development of elite athletes through the EQ High Performance Sport Committee programs.



Medication Control

EQ provided \$31,650 to deliver the Medication Control Program (swabbing) to ensure that all horses are competing without the influence of prohibited substances. This funding is made available through a financial contribution from each new life horse registration with EQ.



Event Funding & Administrative Support

EQ provided \$59,748 to affiliated Clubs and EQ Sport Committees to support the delivery of major events and \$76,000 to EQ Sport Committees to deliver and support discipline specific initiatives.
