

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRIES

EQUESTRIAN OUEENSLAND

- All entries to be made via Equipe.
- Entries open: 8:00pm on Sunday 20 August 2023.
- Entries close: 8:00pm Sunday 24 September 2023.
- No late entries will be accepted after the closing date.
- A \$25 Ambulance levy and a \$25 administration fee will be charged per rider.

Number of Starts:

- Maximum of two starts per horse/day.
- No rider will be permitted more than three (3) entries in a class.
- A horse can only compete in ONE Championship class.

Class Eligibility:

- All qualifier rounds must be the same horse and rider combination, including the final.
- Novice Classes For horses that have not competed 1.20m or higher in the last 6 months.
- Amateur Classes -
 - 1. Amateur rider classes are classes for athletes who:
 - Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing

• In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round or in a 4* 3 day event.

• Must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years

• Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.

• Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.

1.1 Athletes must meet the membership requirements as set out in the EA General Regulations.

1.2 Athletes may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age.

1.3 Organisers may at their discretion limit the number of horses an Athlete can start.
1.4 The course shall be free-flowing and relatively simple. The first obstacle in the first round should be 10cm lower than the advertised starting height of the competition.
1.5 There will be a maximum height rise of 10cm for the jump-off.

Wait Lists:

- Wait lists will be created for classes if over-subscribed, and competitors will be notified of acceptance once nominations are finalised.
- Entries will only be accepted once your payment has been processed.

Equestrian Australia Waivers must be signed for your entry to be accepted – form on Equipe.

Refunds:

Relunds:

- Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$25 administration fee.
- No refunds after close of entries.

CAMPING / STABLE BOOKINGS

• Camping and stable bookings are to be made online via Equipe.







CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

RULES & REGULATIONS

- This event is run under Equestrian Australia rules and regulations.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend the program or any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.

EA Membership and Horse Registration:

- All riders and owners must be current financial members of Equestrian Australia (EA).
- An EQ Come and Try Junior membership is available at \$15 per rider for the 60cm and 70cm classes only and includes both Saturday and Sunday (horses must be EA base registered).
- Riders competing in 1.05m and above must have EA competitor membership and riders competing below 1.05m are required to have a participant or competitor membership.
- All horses competing in 1.05m and above classes must be EA full life registered and have a • current jumping competition licence.
- All horses competing below 1.05m must be EA base registered.
- Riders are able to access their membership information and horse registration details including competition licences on the MyEA online portal or MyEA app. MyEA Portal: <u>https://www.nominate.com.au/EAOnline/portal/Login.aspx</u> MyEA App -Google Play: <u>https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.myea&hl=en&gl=US</u> Apple App Store: <u>https://apps.apple.com/au/app/myea/id1566098449</u>

Championships:

- The top 30 placed horses for each Championship will be selected via the following system:
 - The overall winner of a qualifying class will receive the same number of points as horses in the class e.g. if there are 50 horses in the class, the winner will receive 50 points, 2nd place 49 and so on down to 1 point for the last horse. - The points received in the two classes will be combined and the highest 20 or 30 scores
 - will receive a place in the Championship class.

Other Animals:

No animals other than competition horses are permitted in or around the stable, warm up or competition areas. All other animals must be restrained and kept within the camping area. There is a fully fenced off leash dog park located at the southern end of the camp ground.

Scooters and Bikes:

- Not to be used in or near any competition or warm up areas or stable areas.
- Helmets must be worn.
- Any scooter or bike that is left unattended will be confiscated.

Prams, strollers and the protection of young children:

There is to be no prams, strollers or young children in any warm up areas during the competition.

HORSE HEALTH DECLARATIONS

- Horse Health Declarations (HHD) must be supplied on arrival or emailed prior to competing. The HHD form is on Equipe or available here -
