## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Equisk Queensland Youth Dressage Championships Organising Committee would like to thank you for your entry and wish you the very best of luck at the event. Please read through the following important information regarding the Equisk Queensland Youth Dressage Championships. Regular updates will be posted on the Event web page and on our Facebook page.

## FACILITIES

We request that competitors take the utmost care in looking after the wonderful facilities at PRARG. Please take pride in this fantastic venue and keep the toilets and amenities block clean.

## DOGS

Dogs are NOT permitted at the PRARG grounds. All dogs must remain on leash outside the grounds in the roadside vehicle parking.

## BIOSECURITY

Under Queensland biosecurity legislation, a movement record must be created every time a horse moves off a property. The method of recording is flexible (diary, email, mobile device, copy/photo of Horse Health Dec etc) however the following information must be recorded and kept for 2 years: date of movement, description of the animal, the property of origin (including PIC), event address (including PIC if possible), estimated arrival and departure times and dates and name and contact details of person responsible.

## PRARG IS A LOW RISK VENUE

## PONY MEASURING

Will not be available at this event. If your pony requires measuring please arrange to have this completed prior to the start of competition.

## DRAWS

Draws for all classes will be emailed to you and made available on the official Equisk Queensland Youth Dressage Championships web site <https://www.qld.equestrian.org.au/dressage/youth-championships>

Draws will be continually updated as scratchings are received.

A **final revised** draw may be necessary the day before each competition to allow for withdrawals. The starting order will not alter and a move up system will apply. **The onus is on the competitor to confirm/check their start times the evening before the competition.** All changes will be posted on the event Facebook page and website. We will endeavour to keep changes to a minimum and while appreciated there will not be an expectation to ride up in the event of scratchings.

## WITHDRAWALS/SCRATCHINGS:

- Competitions Refunds will be processed as per the 2025 Equisk Queensland Youth Dressage Championships Schedule.
- Please be aware that as per EA National Dressage Rules no refunds will be given under any circumstance for withdrawals received from the day prior to the start of competition, that is, June 19<sup>th</sup>.

## VETERINARY MATTERS

It is compulsory for all Competitors to fill out and sign a Horse Health Declaration on arrival at the event. The form can be downloaded here:

Please hand these in to gear check or the event office.

**Riders at all levels** must have their horse's **EA papers** available for inspection if requested. **Swabbing** will take place. **Penalty fines** will be imposed for those who do not have their horse papers available at the event.

**Competitors are to pay for any veterinary treatment and supplies provided by Treating Vets during the event.**

If you need to call a vet to attend to your horse while at the event, the Organising Committee **MUST** be notified.

## STALLIONS

All stallion riders, grooms and owners must be aware of and abide by, the EA Stallion Safe Practice Rules and Regulations Policy, effective 1 July, 2018 (reviewed 2021)

## ARENA FAMILIARISATION

Arena Familiarisation will take place as follows:

**Thursday June 19<sup>th</sup>: All arenas 12pm to 4pm**  
**Friday June 20<sup>th</sup>: All arenas 7am to 8am; 3pm to 4pm**  
**Grass arena 7am to 4pm**  
**Saturday June 21<sup>st</sup>: All arenas 3.30pm to 4.30pm**  
**Grass arena 7am to 4.30pm**  
**Sunday June 21<sup>st</sup>: All arenas 7am to 8am**  
**Grass arena 7am to 2pm**

## LUNGEING

Lungeing may only take place in the designated lungeing yard at the southern end of the grass warm-up. Please be respectful of riders competing in Ring 3 – if your lungeing is disturbing riders warming up or undertaking their tests please wait until they have finished before resuming lungeing.

## WARMING UP

For this competition we will be using both Arena 1 (the arena nearest the bushland) and the large grass arena for warm-up.

## STARTING YOUR TEST

Due to space constraints and surface variability for all arenas you will need to enter the arena and start your test from inside the arena once the judge has rung the bell. Riders may enter the arena once the rider before them has exited the arena and are permitted to **trot or canter around the outside track within the arena** prior to the judge ringing the bell. Once the judge has rung the bell the rider will have 45 seconds to commence their test.

## CALLERS

Riders are reminded that as this is a State Championship event NO CALLERS will be permitted.

## GEAR CHECK

**Gear check will take place after tests for ALL competitions.**

You are welcome to request a pre-test visual check that you have all the correct tack and clothing, but this does not replace the official post-test gear check.

## WHIPS & GEAR

EA rules regarding approved gear apply everywhere on the event grounds from the time of arrival at the grounds. Please take particular note of whip, head gear and Horse Identification Number rules. Untagged helmets must be brought to a steward for tagging before being used at the event.

**Whips FEI Competitions:** As this event is a State Championship, it is not permitted to carry a whip of any kind while in the arena for FEI competitions including FEI-Ch, FEI-P and FEI-J.

**Allocated Horse Identification as per the draws** must be worn whenever the horse is out of the stable including leading, grazing or under saddle at any time. Please refer to rule 4.8.5 regarding Horse Identification Number specifications.

Competitors grazing horses must take extreme care and have horses under full control at all times. If grazing horses appear to be upsetting competing horses or horses under saddle, they will be asked to return to the yards. **Please do not graze or lead horses close to the competition arenas when horses are competing.**

## EXEMPTION CARDS

Must be received by June 9<sup>th</sup> 2025

## YARDS & CAMPING

A yard allocation will be sent with the draw along with a parking map. Please **ONLY** use the yard allocated to you. Please ensure you leave yards clean.

## CATERING

Catering will be available during the day from Friday to Sunday.

## TEST PAPERS

This event uses the Nominate paperless scoring. Test sheets will be emailed to riders after signed off by the judge. Check your junk email if you do not receive your email. If it's still not received email Nominate [nominate@nominate.com.au](mailto:nominate@nominate.com.au)

## PRESENTATIONS

Riders are required to be neatly attired in competition clothing for presentations. Presentations in the main will be unmounted and will take place near the Event Office.

**Friday:** All classes 3:30PM

**Saturday:** All classes 4:00PM

**Sunday:** All classes – 2:00PM

Sharon Doe Memorial – mounted presentation on completion of the class

Participation in presentations is compulsory as per the event Schedule. Failure to attend presentation or not being appropriately dressed for presentation will result in forfeiture of your prize money or any prizes. If you cannot attend presentation and wish to obtain your rosette then you need to arrange for someone to collect your rosette for you and notify the event director, Anita Barton, before the presentation. Rosettes and prizes will not be posted.

**Prize money** will be paid as per the EA Dressage Rules and the Event Schedule and deposited into your nominated bank account within 14 working days of the event.

## CHAMPIONSHIPS

EA & FEI Level Championships will be decided from both tests as per rule 3.19.

## VOLUNTEERING

Volunteering is compulsory at this event, unless you opted to pay the non-volunteer fee with your entries.

If you are unable to make your job for any reason it is up to you to find a replacement. Failure to present for your allotted job without finding a replacement may result in sanctions, including payment of a \$50 non-volunteering fee.

## RIDER BAGS

Each rider will receive a Equisk Queensland Youth Dressage Championships riders bag. If you have purchased a Commemorative Polo Shirt or saddlecloth (ordered and paid for at the time of entry) this can be collected from the Event Office from Thursday June 19<sup>th</sup>. Rider bags can be collected from the Event Office during the event.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

**Code of conduct:** The organising committee of the Equisk Queensland Youth Dressage Championships and Queensland Dressage Championships values the attendance of all riders, officials, spectators, sponsors, volunteers and supporters HOWEVER it is a condition of attendance at this event that each person present on the grounds is bound by the rules, policies and by-laws of Equestrian Australia. This includes comments made on social media. Any complaints or conflicts should be managed with respect through official channels. As per EA Disciplinary By-Laws 3(j) any other person or organisation (for example, a parent/guardian, spectator or sponsor) who or which agrees, in writing or otherwise (whether on a ticket, entry form, conditions of entry displayed at a venue etc) to be bound by these By-Laws. Any rider, parent, official or associate to be found in breach of these By-Laws will be requested to leave the venue immediately and all entry fees and prizes deemed forfeit.
