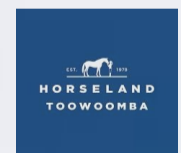

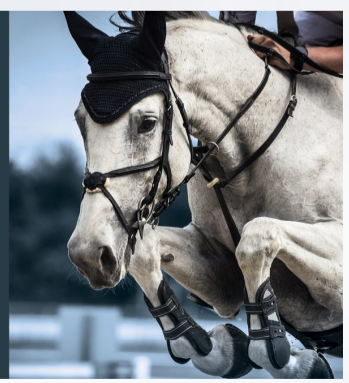

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All Entries Via Global Entries Online - Online Entries only (no phone, email or entries on the day will be accepted). Late entries will not be accepted.
- **All contact regarding the show and entries MUST be sent to jqevents@equestrianqld.com.au**
NO OTHER FORMS OF CONTACT WILL BE RESPONDED TO.
- Horse health declarations and rider waivers must be completed prior to competition commencing. NO FORMS will be available on the day. **No HHD or rider waiver NO RIDE.**
- This event is run under EA rules.
- Limit of 2 starts per horse, per day on Friday and Saturday in all arenas.
- **Horses may only compete in 1 championship class on Sunday.**
- Draws will be posted on Global Entries Online and the event will run to draw order with Arena 1 taking precedence.
- **Refunds** of entries will be given in full before close of entry date, less a \$25 administration fee. After entries have closed, a 50% refund less \$25 administration fee will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate. Once the event has commenced there will be no refunds given. You must contact the OC as refunds are not processed automatically. There will be no refunds given for stables or camping fees after close of entries. Notice of scratchings must be emailed to jqevents@equestrianqld.com.au
- All horses and riders competing above 105cm **MUST** hold a Full Life registration and Competitor Licence with EA. Riders competing below 104cm must hold at least a Participant membership and Base Registration with EA.
- First aid will be in attendance all 3 days.
- This Event is open to EA members only. All horse registration, rider and owner membership numbers must be provided and an entry check will be carried out by Equestrian Queensland.
Nominations will not be accepted if membership or registration details are incorrect.
- **DISCLAIMER** - statement of liability - neither the organising committee or EA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- **DRESS -**
All riders to be dressed in accordance to FEI requirements and those attired incorrectly will not be permitted to start (light coloured breeches, white collared shirt (tie for men) and jacket).
- EA helmet standards will apply and all helmets must be tagged.
- All riders must wear riding boots and an approved safety helmet while mounted.
- The organising committee reserves the right at their discretion to alter or amend any of the conditions, regulations or any aspect of the event as they see fit.
- **SWABBING -**
The organising committee reserves the right to swab horses. Random swabbing of horses may be conducted in any official class. Horses chosen for swabbing must proceed directly to the swabbing box immediately after presentation.
- **BEHAVIOUR -** All competitors must obey EA rules and competition etiquette, those who fail to do so risk elimination from the competition. Should any persons fail to adhere to the code of conduct they will be asked to leave the property.
- **ABUSE -** Abusive behaviour towards any personnel involved in the organisation and running of this event will not be tolerated. Any person inflicting abuse upon such personnel will be asked to leave the premises and all entries will be forfeited. The FEI requires all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the Horse must be paramount. Welfare of the Horse must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences. We have a zero tolerance policy towards cruel and violent treatment of any person or animal.
- Damage to any third party by anyone at the competition will be the responsibility of the adult involved or the parents or guardians of those who cause any damage.
- **SADDLERY and EQUIPMENT -** All equipment should comply with EA regulations. It is the responsibility of the competitor and/or parents to ensure that the saddlery and equipment is in good repair and meets the relevant safety standards and is fitted appropriately.
- **PRESENTATIONS -** All place getters **must** present for prizes mounted or prize money will be forfeited. Stallions may be substituted for another horse for presentations.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All riders competing at the event will be expected to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry.
- **Extra fees to be paid with entries through Global Entries Online:**
 - \$15.00 Medical levy fee Per Day, Per Rider
 - \$10.00 Admin levy fee Per Day, Per Horse
 - \$5.00 Ground levy fee Per Day, Per Horse
 - Stabling - \$50.00 Per Night, Per Horse + \$25.00 Bond Per Stable
 - Camping - \$50.00 Per Night
 - Live Editing - \$10.00 Per Change

CLASS ELIGIBILITY

- **Classes with A or B sections - you are only permitted to enter either A or B not multiple sections.**
- **Children's Championship -**
Athletes may compete in Children's classes from the calendar year they turn 10 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14 years old.
- **Junior Riders -**
As per EA National Jumping rules.
- **Amateur Rider -**
Riders Must be 21 years of age and above. Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing, in the last 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round. Must not have competed in section 1 or 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years. Must never have competed in a 4* 3 day event. Amateur riders may not compete in an amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at the show. Amateur Riders may not compete in an amateur class on a horse that will be competing in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at the show.
- **Futurity Class -** Futurity rules apply. Open to horses that are 6yrs, 7yrs or 8yrs on the day of competition, there is no point restriction. The height for the first round will be 1.25/1.30m starting height and the Jump off will have a maximum height of 1.40m.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

CLASS ELIGIBILITY CONTINUED

- **Queensland Off-The-Track Classes -** To be eligible for the Queensland Off-The-Track (QOTT) classes your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book. No part bred thoroughbreds will be eligible. Any prize money will be paid to the winning rider. Connections of the horse must organise the prize money split, if any, between themselves. Any horses and riders competing in the QOTT classes 1.05m and over must also hold EA full life registration.

BIOSECURITY, HEALTH & SAFETY

Other Animals -

- No animals other than competition horses are permitted in or around the stable, warm up or competition areas.
- All other animals must be restrained and kept within the camping area.
- There is a full fenced off leash dog park located at the southern end of the campground.

Scooters and Bikes -

- Not to be used in or near any competition or warm up areas or stable areas
- Helmets must be worn
- Any scooter or bike that is left unattended will be confiscated

Prams, strollers and the protection of young children -

- There are to be **no prams, strollers or young children in any warm up areas** during the competition.
