EA CEO is currently reviewing the EA Coaching Committee charter with potential changes to an Advisory Group due to the perceived conflict of interest. The review would then align with Sports Australia framework and AICD. Any decisions made by the EQ CAG should come back to EQ board to be ratified. Original EQ CAG appointed in 2018. Reviewed EQ Terms of Reference tabled with suggested changes and added to propose a term of each of the members, suggested 2 years, and serve no more than two consecutive terms. EQ to run an expression of interest process before the end of 2020, with the intent to retain some existing highly skilled members and add new members to support succession planning.
