OPEN TROPHIES

Open Trophy Criteria

1. Scores must be obtained from at least two Queensland events.
2. The average of the highest 6 official competitive results over 60% at the trophy level will be counted.
3. Only average scores where two or more judges have been used will be used to calculate end of year trophies
4. No Interschool or participation scores will be eligible for Dressage Queensland Open Trophies
5. Scores from Youth/Young Rider or AOR only competitions are not eligible
6. HC scores will not be considered
7. All Queensland affiliated club official competitive results will be included along with all Australian State Championships, National Championships and CDIs
8. A maximum of one score only from an interstate official competitive event that is NOT a State/National Championship or CDI may be included
9. The weightings to be used on all results (excluding Young Horse) to be counted towards Dressage Queensland Trophies shall be as follows:

- Trophy is awarded to a Queensland horse that achieves the highest average percentage of their top 3 scores taken from any 4 year old Australian Young Horse competition
- At least ONE score must be obtained from a Queensland-Affiliated Club Event
- Where the competition is run over two rounds to decide the place-getters, scores will be taken from both rounds

Dressage Queensland 5 Year Old Young Horse Champion and runner-up of the Year

- Qualifying period is from August 1st of the preceding year to July 31st of the award year
- Trophy is awarded to a Queensland horse that achieves the highest average percentage of their top 3 scores taken from any 5 year old Australian Young Horse competition
- At least ONE score must be obtained from a Queensland-Affiliated Club Event
- Where the competition is run over two rounds to decide the place-getters, scores will be taken from both rounds

Dressage Queensland 6 Year Old Young Horse Champion and runner-up of the Year

- Qualifying period is from August 1st of the preceding year to July 31st of the award year
- Trophy is awarded to a Queensland horse that achieves the highest average percentage of their top 3 scores taken from any 6 year old Australian Young Horse competition
- At least ONE score must be obtained from a Queensland-Affiliated Club Event
- Where the competition is run over two rounds to decide the place-getters, scores will be taken from both rounds

Dressage Queensland 7 Year Old Young Horse Champion and runner-up of the Year

- Qualifying period is from August 1st of the preceding year to July 31st of the award year
- Trophy is awarded to a Queensland horse that achieves the highest average percentage of their top 3 scores taken from any 7 year old Australian Young Horse competition
- At least ONE score must be obtained from a Queensland-Affiliated Club Event
- Where the competition is run over two rounds to decide the place-getters, scores will be taken from both rounds

SELF NOMINATED OPEN TROPHIES

Spin Memorial Newcomer Horse of the Year

- To be eligible, the horse must not have competed in official competitive competition prior to the current competition year (horses having competed in only young horse events prior to the calendar year will be still be eligible).
- 4 results in total are required as per Open criteria
 - At least 2 official/competitive preliminary results are required
 - 2 other official/competitive scores at any level will count for the balance
 - Scores from Young Horse classes will not be eligible
 - Scores from Interschool, Young Rider and AOR only events will not be eligible
 - Scores from freestyles will not be eligible
 - Scores will be weighted as per above

Riders must apply for this award using the appropriate form on the DQ website by 31st October.

OPEN PONY TROPHIES

Pony Trophy Criteria

1. Open to all riders on Ponies
2. Scores must be obtained from at least two Queensland events.
3. The average of the highest 6 official competitive results over 60% at the trophy level will be counted.
4. Only average scores where two or more judges have been used will be used to calculate end of year trophies
5. No Interschool or participation scores will be considered eligible for Pony Trophies
6. HC scores will not be considered
7. Scores from Youth/Young Rider and AOR only competitions are not eligible
8. All Queensland affiliated club official results will be included along with All Australian State Championships and National Championships/CDIs
9. A maximum of one score only from an interstate official competitive event that is NOT a State/National Championship or CDI may be included
10. The weightings to be used on all results (excluding Young Pony) to be counted towards Dressage Queensland Trophies shall be as follows:

Dressage Queensland Novice Champion and Runner-up Pony of the Year

- Trophy is awarded to a Queensland pony that achieves the highest average percentage of their top 3 scores taken from any 4 year old Australian Young Pony competition
- At least ONE score must be obtained from a Queensland-Affiliated Club Event
- Where the competition is run over two rounds to decide the place-getters, scores will be taken from both rounds

Toowoomba Dressage Group 5 Year Old Young Pony Champion and runner-up of the Year

- Qualifying period is from August 1st of the preceding year to July 31st of the award year

- Trophy is awarded to a Queensland pony that achieves the highest average percentage of their top 3 scores taken from any 5 year old Australian Young Pony competition
- At least ONE score must be obtained from a Queensland-Affiliated Club Event
- Where the competition is run over two rounds to decide the place-getters, scores will be taken from both rounds

Toowoomba Dressage Group 6 Year Old Young Pony Champion and runner-up of the Year

- Qualifying period is from August 1st of the preceding year to July 31st of the award year
- Trophy is awarded to a Queensland pony that achieves the highest average percentage of their top 3 scores taken from any 6 year old Australian Young Pony competition
- At least ONE score must be obtained from a Queensland-Affiliated Club Event
- Where the competition is run over two rounds to decide the place-getters, scores will be taken from both rounds

Toowoomba Dressage Group 7 Year Old Young Pony Champion and runner-up of the Year

- Qualifying period is from August 1st of the preceding year to July 31st of the award year
- Trophy is awarded to a Queensland pony that achieves the highest average percentage of their top 3 scores taken from any 7 year old Australian Young Pony competition
- At least ONE score must be obtained from a Queensland-Affiliated Club Event
- Where the competition is run over two rounds to decide the place-getters, scores will be taken from both rounds

SELF NOMINATED PONY TROPHIES

Sommerlyne Lisa Newcomer Pony of the Year

- To be eligible, the pony must not have competed in official competitive competition prior to the current competition year (ponies having competed in only young pony events prior to the calendar year will be still be eligible).
- 4 results in total are required as per Open Pony criteria:
 - At least 2 official/competitive preliminary results are required
 - 2 other official/competitive scores at any level will count for the balance
 - Scores from Young Pony classes will not be eligible
 - Scores from restricted Youth/Young Rider only or AOR only competitions are not eligible
 - Scores from Interschool and Eventing events will not be eligible
 - Scores from Freestyles will not be eligible
 - Scores will be weighted

Riders must apply for this award using the appropriate form on the DQ website by 31st October.

YOUNG RIDER TROPHIES

Young Rider Trophy Criteria

1. Scores must come from at least two Queensland events.
2. The average of the highest 6 official competitive results over 60% at the trophy level will be counted.
3. Only average scores where two or more judges have been used will be used to calculate end of year trophies
4. No Interschool or participation scores will be considered eligible for Young Rider Trophies
5. Young Rider Trophy contenders' ages are 8-21. (from the start of the calendar year they turn 8 years of age to the end of calendar year they turn 21 years of age)
6. HC scores will not be considered
7. Only the same combination (rider & horse) will count
8. All Queensland-affiliated club Competitive events, Australian and Youth Rider State Championships, National Championships and CDIs results will be included.
9. A maximum of one score only from an interstate official competitive event that is NOT a State/National Championship or CDI may be included
10. The weightings to be used on all results to be counted towards Dressage Queensland Trophies shall be as follows:

Redlands Vet Clinic Preliminary/Novice Champion and runner up Young Rider of the Year

- Open to young rider combinations, having competed at the Preliminary and Novice levels in the current year
- Combinations do not have to have competed in both levels to be eligible, however;
- At least 3 scores MUST be achieved at Novice level
- *As per YR Trophy Criteria above*

Wintercourt Equestrian Elementary Champion and runner up Young Rider of the Year

- Open to young rider combinations, having competed at Elementary or CDI-P level in the current year
- *As per YR Trophy Criteria above*

O. M. Nunn Medium Champion and runner up Young Rider of the Year

- Open to young rider combinations, having competed at Medium or CDI-J level in the current year
- *As per YR Trophy Criteria above*

Equine Property Services Advanced Champion and runner up Young Rider of the Year

- Open to young rider combinations, having competed at Advanced level in the current year
- *As per YR Trophy Criteria above*

Irene Bakels-Noreen Young Riders PSG/Inter 1 Trophy and runner up

- Open to YR combinations, having competed PSG/Inter I level in the current year
- Combinations do not have competed in both levels to be eligible
- CDI-Y scores are eligible
- *As per Young Rider Trophy Criteria above*

Dressage Queensland Medium/Big Tour Champion and runner up Young Rider of the Year

- Open to YR combinations, having competed Inter A/B/II or Grand Prix level in the current year
- Combinations do not have competed in both levels or tours to be eligible
- Under-25 Big Tour scores are eligible
- As per *Young Rider Trophy Criteria* above

SELF NOMINATED YOUNG RIDER TROPHIES

The Diarmin Park Newcomer Young Rider of the Year

- This trophy is to encourage young riders to compete in official competitive dressage competitions.
- This is a rider award for a young rider who is competing in official competitive competitions for the first time in the award year
- It is awarded to the young rider obtaining the highest average percentage of 3 competitions at any level
- Rider has never competed in an official/competitive dressage competition in Australia or any other country before the current trophy year
- Any level can be ridden - Preliminary, Novice etc.
- As per *Young Rider Trophy Criteria* above
- Scores obtained in elementary will accrue an additional weighting of 1.02
- Scores obtained in medium and above will accrue an additional weighting of 1.04
- Scores from Young Rider State and National Championships are eligible
- Riders must be aged between 8-21 years old (from the start of the calendar year they turn 8 years of age to the end of calendar year they turn 21 years of age)
- Scores from Young Horse/Pony classes will not be eligible
- Scores from Interschool events will not be eligible
- Scores from Freestyles will not be eligible

Riders must apply for this award using the appropriate form on the DQ website by 31st October.

1. For riders aged 22 years and above the meet the EA criteria of being an Amateur Owner Rider.
2. At least 2 scores must be obtained at Queensland competitions.
3. The average of the highest 6 official competitive results over 60% at the trophy level will be counted.
4. Only average scores where two or more judges have been used will be used to calculate end of year trophies
5. No participation scores will be eligible for Dressage Queensland Adult Amateur Owner Rider Trophies
6. Scores from restricted Youth/Young Rider only competitions are not eligible
7. HC scores will not be considered
8. All Queensland affiliated club official competitive results will be included along with all Australian State Championships, National Championships and CDIs
9. The weightings to be used on all results to be counted towards Dressage Queensland Trophies shall be as follows:

- At least 2 scores MUST be obtained at GP
- Scores 58% and above will be considered

SELF NOMINATED SENIOR RIDER TROPHIES

The Lung Family Newcomer Rider of the Year

- This trophy is to encourage riders to compete in official competitive dressage events.
- This is a rider award for a rider aged 21 years or older who is competing in official/competitive events for the first time in the award year
- Open to riders on horses and ponies
- Only the same combination (rider & horse) will be considered
- It is awarded to the rider obtaining the highest average percentage of 3 competitions at any level
- Rider has never competed in an official dressage competition in Australia or any other country before the current trophy year
- As per Open horse or pony criteria
- Any level can be ridden - Preliminary, Novice etc.
- At least 2 scores must be obtained at Queensland events.
- Scores obtained in elementary will accrue an additional weighting of 1.02
- Scores obtained in medium and above will accrue an additional weighting of 1.04
- Scores from Young Horse/Pony classes will not be eligible
- Scores from AOR restricted events are eligible
- HC scores will not be considered

Riders must apply for this award using the appropriate form on the DQ website by 31st October.

SELF NOMINATED TROPHIES OPEN TO JUNIOR & SENIOR

Dressage Queensland Pat Dale Memorial Trophy

- Open to a Queensland rider having competed at official competitive Elementary level for the first time in the award year
- Eligible to all riders aged 8yo and over
- It is awarded to the rider obtaining the highest average percentage (unweighted scores) of 3 competitions at elementary

Riders must apply for this award using the appropriate form on the DQ website by 31st October.

The Crisp Emerging FEI Rider

- Open to a Queensland rider having competed at competitive FEI level for the first time in the award year
- Eligible to all riders aged 12yo and over
- It is awarded to the rider obtaining the highest average percentage (unweighted scores) of 3 FEI competitions
- Any open FEI level can be ridden, including CDI-Y and under 25 Inter II/Grand Prix
- Scores from the following competitions are not considered eligible for this award, and also do not count as prior FEI competition (ie a rider may have competed previously in these classes and still be eligible for this award in the future)
 - CDI-P
 - CDI-J
 - Restricted classes (ie an FEI futurity) or exhibition classes (ie Sharon Doe Memorial)

Riders must apply for this award using the appropriate form on the DQ website by 31st October.

STATE SELECTORS CHOICE TROPHIES

Dressage Queensland FEI Horse of the Year

- Open to Equestrian Queensland-registered combinations, having competed at FEI in the current year
- Focus placed upon Queensland representation at major interstate events and CDI results
- One score must come from a Queensland-affiliated club event
- Open to Australian-based combinations only

ELD EA Young Rider of the Year

- Open to young riders 8-21yrs inclusive competing in official EA classes
- Open to riders on both horses and ponies
- One score must come from a Queensland-affiliated club event
- The winner will be selected from the highest ranked young riders in each competition level (eg prelim, novice, elementary etc)

Sandale Saddlery and Stubben Saddle FEI Youth Rider of the Year

- Open to young and youth riders aged between 12- 25yrs inclusive
- Open to riders on both horses and ponies
- One score must come from a Queensland-affiliated club event
- The winner will be selected from riders participating in FEI classes (Prix St George to Grand Prix) in the current year
- Young rider (CDI-Y) and under 25 Big Tour results from State and National Championships (including Youth Championships) and CDI's will also be considered
- Focus will be placed upon Queensland representation at major interstate events and CDI results
- Open to Australian-based combinations only

Dressage Queensland Regional Rider of the Year

- Open to riders whose primary place of residence is 400km or greater from Brisbane CDI competing in official EA classes
- Riders must show demonstrated participation at regional club events
- Riders must submit six results over 60% with a minimum of two from regional club events
- This is a performance-based award and recipients will be selected based on demonstrated consistent results

SPECIAL NOMINATED AWARDS

Vince Corvi Tribute Award

- Awarded to a Special Individual who has made a significant contribution to the sport of Dressage over a number of years, either as an Administrator, Coach, Mentor, Volunteer or Official
- The award is self-nominating or an individual can be nominated by someone else filling in the nomination form
- An applicant is only eligible to win this award once every 5 years ie if you have previously won this award you will not be eligible to be nominated for 5 years after the year of winning

Applicants must apply for this award using the appropriate form on the DQ website by 31st October.

OFFICIALS SUB-COMMITTEE AWARDS

Dressage Queensland Officials Sub-Committee Senior Judge of the Year Award

- This award recognises the service that judges give to the sport.

Award Criteria

- Senior Judge of the Year is awarded to a C to A level judge
- Up to date with qualifications
- High availability to all Dressage competitions - Club Days, Associate and Official
- Consistency and relevance of marks
- Service to self-development and/or development of further judges
- Shows a desire and willingness to increase skill base and knowledge
- Approachability and willingness to communicate with the DQOSC, fellow judges and riders for self-analysis
- The recipient will be decided upon by the DQOSC

Clare Mathews Junior Judge of the Year Award

- This award recognises the service that judges give to the sport.

Award Criteria

- Junior Judge of the Year is awarded to an F to C level judge with a minimum 3 years active experience
- Up to date with qualifications
- High availability to all Dressage competitions - Club Days, Associate and Official
- Consistency and relevance of marks
- Service to self-development and/or development of further judges
