- Horse health declarations must be completed BEFORE arrival to the grounds.
- All riders entering this event will be expected to have read and accepted these Conditions of Entry.
- Wait lists will be created if and when required for all classes. The committee will review numbers after close of nominations and advise applicants.

- There will be no refunds given for stabling and camping after close of entries.
 Scratching's after the close of entries will receive a refund of your class entry fees less the administration fees provided the scratching is accompanied by a Vet or Doctor certificate. Once the event has commenced there will be no refunds given. Any refunds given will be processed after the events completion. All scratching's must be emailed to equipaust@gmail.com
- In the event the show has to be cancelled due to covid or any other reason out of the organisers control after close of entries, \$60 of your entry fees will be retained to cover costs already incurred.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend the program or any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.
- Stabling will be at the block fee of \$350 per stable for the event
- Build your own yards are permitted for the cost of \$50 per horse for the event.
- Polo yards are available at a cost of \$55 per yard for the duration of the event.
- Undercover polo yards are available at a cost of \$100 per yard for the duration of the event.
- Powered Camping will have a block fee of \$160 for the duration of the event.
- Unpowered campsites on the island are available for a block fee of \$40 for the duration of the event.
- No Electric Fences are allowed
- \$12 per rider /per day Ambulance levy will be charged.
- A \$5 administration fee per horse / per day will be charged on each rider's nominations.
- Horses are allowed two starts per day.





- World Cup horses ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE MINI PRIX CLASS AT THIS EVENT
- Future Stars & Mini Prix Series classes are a block entry.
- Points over the two Qualifying rounds count towards the final. The top 25 combinations overall will be invited into the finals.
- Where there is an A and B section to a class, you must choose either A or B you cannot compete in both
- A horse can only compete in ONE Championship class
- A \$25 Ground Levy fee will be charged on each rider's nominations.
- The age of the horse or rider will remain as from the START of the show.
- Ring 1 will be strictly draw order ONLY
- All placegetters MUST present at presentations mounted (stallions may be substituted with another horse for presentations), or prizemoney is forfeited
- All riders and owners must be financial members of the EA to compete and all horses competing in official classes must hold current EA registration and performance cards. Riders may be required to present horse registration/performance cards upon request of the committee.
- All horse nominated must hold current registration and grading papers (electronic card) from their relevant Equestrian State Branch.
- DRESS All riders to be dressed according to the FEI requirements and those attired incorrectly will not be allowed to start.
- Australian Helmet standards will apply, all helmets must be tagged.
- All riders must wear riding boots and an approved helmet at all times while mounted.
- SWABBING: The Organising Committee reserves the right to swab horses.
 Random swabbing of horses may be conducted in any class. Horses chosen for swabbing must proceed directly to the swabbing box immediately after the presentation.
- Disclaimer Statement of liability Neither the organising committee,
 Larapinta Equestrian or EA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- Damage to any third party by anyone at the competition will be the responsibility of the adult involved or the parents/guardians of those who cause the damage.





- All horses nominated in TSHA classes MUST be registered with TSHA (see TSHA rules)
- Dogs MUST be on a lead or secured at all times. Dog waste must be collected.
- Manure is to be deposited in signed areas ONLY Tractor and bucket must be able to access.
- Please note all rings will pause whilst the World Cup takes place should they be still running.
- The organising committee reserves the right to refuse any entries.
- Electric Scooters may be used however helmets must be worn and must not be ridden under the influence of alcohol.
- There is to be no swimming or water activities in the lake.
- NO HORSES ARE ALLOWED ON THE BANK ON THE TOP SIDE OF THE FIELD

World Cup

- The Closing Date for WORLD CUP entries will be 12th of April 2024 at 3pm. No entries for this event will be accepted after this date.
- It is now a FEI requirement that World Cup horses MUST be stabled on the grounds for 24 hours before the World Cup Class, so therefore World Cup Horses MUST be at the grounds by 10am on Friday the 26th of April 2024.

Future Stars classes

- For Horses that are 6, 7 & 8 years from date of birth on the first day of competition.
- Any Horse that has started in a World Cup Class cannot compete in any Future Stars, Futurity or Stars of the Futures classes.

12 and Under Class

• For riders 12 years and under from their date of birth as of the first day of competition.





Article 255 – Amateur Riders

- Amateur Rider classes are classes for Athletes who:
- Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing
- In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round or in a 4* 3 day event.
- Must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at the show.
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a Horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.
- 1.1 Athletes must meet the membership requirements as set out in the EA General Regulations.
- 1.2 Athletes may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age. Equestrian Australia National Jumping Rules 45

Future Stars Final / Mini Prix

- A horse may not compete in both the Future Stars and Mini Prix sections
- The top 25 placed horses for the Final will be selected via the following system:
- 1. The overall winner of a qualifying class will receive the same number of points as horses in the class e.g. if there are 50 horses in the class, the winner will receive 51 points, 2nd place 49 and so on down to 1 point for the last horse
- 2. The points received in the two classes will be combined and the highest 25 scores will receive a place in the Final class.

Class 32 Saddleworld Ipswich 1.05m Championships

• Horses eligible for this class must be in either their first or second year of registration. The horse must also have not competed in a competition at 1.20m high or above within the last six months.





Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association Rules and Registration Instructions

All horses entering the thoroughbred classes must have a TSHA licence. TSHA licences can be purchased on Global Entries online. Log in to Global Entries and go to "manage horses" to fill in all details and pay for licence.
