Rules for Jigsaw Jumping (Pairs)

The class will be run under Art 268 - Relay Competitions.

In the jigsaw, the pair of riders enter the ring together. The two riders must each jump 6 obstacles on the course at the same time.

Each obstacle can only be jumped once.

Both horses must go through the start and finish peg. The time is taken from the moment that the first horse crosses the finish line. If one horse is eliminated, the pair will be eliminated.
