


PLEASE NOTE DIRECTIONS & PARKING FOR HORSE FLOATS & TRUCKS

# **BIOSECURITY RULES**

- All persons in charge of horses / livestock entering the grounds are encouraged to actively practise good Biosecurity principles.
- A Horse Health Declaration will accompany ALL horses entering the ground, including those not competing.
- Event entry will be refused without the submission of these forms.

NO SPECTATORS, CHILDREN, STROLLERS, OR DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE MAIN ARENA THROUGHOUT THE SHOW.

ONE HANDLER ONLY PER HORSE WILL BE ALLLOWED IN THE RING.

THIS IS A WORKPLACE HEALTH & SAFETY REQUIREMENT.

A qualified Ambulance Bearer from Emergency First Aid Services will be located in ring centre and a van beside the Secretary's Office will be equipped with full emergency gear.

#### THE NOMINATION BOX WILL BE LOCATED BENEATH THE ANNOUNCER'S BOX

Nomination box will be open from 7.00am to 10.00am. After **10.00am nominations & stable enquiries** can be made in ring centre. **By lodging your nomination on the day you accept the rules, by laws and regulations of the Show Society.** 

#### E.F.A. rules apply in all Hacking and Showjumping events.

Horses entered in any class to be measured at the discretion of the stewards.

#### Horses entered in any class may be swabbed at the discretion of the stewards. EFA RULES WILL APPLY.

The Ring Committee reserves the right to change the sequence of events at its discretion.

Competitors are expected to check the rings and be on time for their respective classes.

An exhibitor shall ensure that horse and competitor are entered and shown only in the correct classes.

Penalties will be incurred at the Society's discretion should this rule be violated.

The judge's decision shall be final. No competitor or exhibitor shall approach a judge with regard to a decision unless they first obtain permission from the Chief' Steward or Ring Steward.

All riders enter these events at their own risk. Neither the organising committee, nor the Brookfield Show Society accept any responsibility for injury to any person, horse or property howsoever caused.

Because District Events are restricted events, awards won do not affect eligibility for the rest of the Show. However, they will restrict competition in district events in future years.

PRIZE MONEY: The following prize money and entry fee will apply unless otherwise stated.

1st: \$8.00 2nd: \$5.00. Ribbons to 6th place. Entry: \$5.00. Pairs: 1st: \$8.00. 2nd: \$5.00. Ribbons to 6th place. Entry: \$5.00 per pair.

Debut: Debut Hack is one that has never been shown under saddle before. A Debut Hack can only compete in a debut class once.

Maiden: Maiden Hack / Rider is one that has never won a first prize as a hack/rider at a provincial show in Open or District Classes.

Novice: Novice Hack is one that has not won an Open or District Championship as a hack at a provincial show.

Top boots may not be worn by riders under 17 years in Rider classes.

**E.F.A.** Approved Safety Helmets are compulsory for riders under 17 years.
