- Have a good understanding of the EA rules
- Have excellent communication skills and show respect for all
- Be able to problem solve
- Work well as part of a team

- ✓ Outline what the Steward did at events that stood out for you
- ✓ Describe any obstacles that the Steward overcame to make events run smoothly
