
Q1 Which of the following applies to your organising committee?



Q2 Does your committee believe that some events should require Hendra vaccination as a condition of entry?



Q3 Has your committee conducted a condition of entry HVE previously?



Q4 If yes to the above, did the HVE condition of entry impact on reducing the number of nominations for the event?



Q5 Is your committee considering holding a condition of entry HVE for future events?



Q6 What factors have influenced your committee consideration of holding a condition of entry HVE event? (select all that apply)








Q7 If your committee is considering holding a HVE as a condition of entry for future events, will it offer an exemption process for horses that have had adverse reactions?


