# **Equestrian Australia Rules and EQ Conditions of Entry**

# All National Qualifying classes will be run in accordance with EA National ShowHorse Rules effective 1st July 2022

#### 1. Rules

It is the responsibility of all competitors and officials to be familiar with all current rules and to conduct themselves in accordance with EA Policies, particularly the Code of Conduct and Horse Welfare. Reference may also be made to FEI publications. **All RIDERS** must wear protective headgear to the current Australian Standard. The retaining chin straps must be fastened at all times.

# 2. Judge Access

No person shall approach a Judge for the duration of the event unless they first obtain permission from the Ring master or Ring Steward. A competitor seeking the opinion of a Judge must do so under the supervision of a Steward. If it is brought to the attention of the organizing committee that any owner/rider/exhibitor/lessee has been in contact with and/or makes contact with an appointed judge at any stage throughout the duration of the show, that owner/rider/exhibitor/lessee will automatically forfeit their right to entry. No Competitor/Spectator shall enter the judges/officials shade tent, or you will automatically forfeit your placing.

#### 3. Protests

Protests containing irregularities or incidents during a class or competition or the classification of a call or competition no later than 60 minutes after the posting of the results of such class or competition. All protests shall be accompanied by a cash fee of \$200.00 which shall be forfeited should the protest be deemed frivolous.

# 4. Payments and refunds

Payments are NON-REFUNDABLE at closure date and NON-TRANSFERABLE (Transferable entry money may be considered with a vet certificate). If the event is cancelled by Show Horse Queensland, the refund entries less the administration fee.

# 5. Prize/s

Any prize/s not collected on the day of the show will be forfeited.

#### 6. **Biosecurity**

All Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration forms must be submitted to the Show Office on the day of arrival and prior to the commencement of the show. Horse health declarations can be found here:

- 7. All Newcomer horses **must not** have competed under saddle before the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022. A Statutory Declaration must be provided if requested. All Newcomer horses and ponies must have competed at their first show in Queensland to be eligible as a Newcomer. All newcomers that have not competed under saddle before the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022 are eligible in the States HOTY and do not need to meet the two (2) qualifying shows as mentioned in item 11 below.
- 8. Open Show Horse and Show Hunter Classes will be your own workout for 2 ½ minutes only. (A bell will sound, and you will be no longer be judged after the 2mins)

Rider Classes will have a set workout. Lead Rein Classes will have a set workout.

#### 9. Music

- Please refer to the below criteria when submitting music:
- The music to be supplied in .MP3 format
- MPORTANT\*\* If the file is .MP4 from an Apple device, please ensure it is converted to an .MP3 file before sending. Please make a note in your email to advise if the file has been converted.

  Special attention will be paid to these tracks to ensure no glitches during the conversion process.
- Tracks with offensive language will NOT be played.
- The file must be supplied PLAY READY. The track will be started when the rider approaches the ring
- The time allowed for each workout is two and a half minutes.
- If no track is supplied, there will be no music played for that competitor.
- Music is not compulsory.
- No Fee is associated with submitting music.
- Additional information to be supplied for each track: Rider's Name, Horse Name and Class Number.
- The file is to be named in the following format: SallySmith(5).MP3 "Sally Smith" is the rider's name and she is using this track for class 5.
- The deadline for receipt of music for the CHILD'S HOTY show is 5pm Friday 2 September

- 10. Horses and Ponies must be full life registered with Equestrian Queensland. Horses and Ponies must resident in Queensland for a minimum of three months & one day prior to the start date of this show. All horses must carry and present a current height certificate for any classes in which they are nominating in at each show. Horses cannot compete at any EQ show on a Temporary Height Certificate
- 11. Horses and Riders must have qualified to compete in any class entered at Show Horse Queensland's qualifying shows. If you are wishing to enter Show Horse Queensland HOTY 17 & 18 September 2022 then you are required to participate at TWO (2) EQ Show Horse Queensland Qualifying Hack events.

  To clarify, you must attend/compete/participate in the ring at two (2) Show Horse Queensland qualifying events. Exemptions requests as it relates to regional members (i.e. 400km from Brisbane) and the requirement for two (2) qualifying shows should be forwarded to <a href="mailto:showhorseqld@equestriangld.com.au">showhorseqld@equestriangld.com.au</a> by no later than 15 August, 2022.
- 12. All Owners, Riders, Exhibitors and Lessees, entered or competing in the Show Horse Queensland HOTY must be a financial Competitor level member of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. and all horses entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be full life registration with the Equestrian Australia (with QLD residency address on registration papers) Inc. Such membership/registrations shall be effective by close of entries.
- 13. All Horses must be Gear Checked before entering the ring by a Gear Check Steward.
- 14. No alcohol is to be permitted on the grounds near the competition area or during the official competing starting time and finishing time each day.
- 15. Leader Board Points Horse/Rider combinations cannot have a mixture of points for Show Hunter and Show Horse classes. Once you start in Show Horse or Show Hunter you must accumulate points for the High Points Award in the Show Horse or Show Hunter classes only current leaderboard standings can be found here <a href="https://www.qld.equestrian.org.au/show-horse/series-leaderboard">https://www.qld.equestrian.org.au/show-horse/series-leaderboard</a>
