Equestrian Australia Rules and EQ Conditions of Entry – Rules

1. It is the responsibility of all owners, riders and exhibitors and lessees to be familiar with and aware of all Equestrian Australia rules which govern this sport. For example; the constitution, by-law and policies consist of, but are not limited to: Codes of Conduct, Equine Anti-Doping and Medication Control Regulations.

Equestrian Australia National Show Horse Rules as at 1 January 2023

All owners, riders, exhibitors and lessees, entered or competing in the Equestrian Queensland Show must be financial members of Equestrian Australia. Membership shall be effective by the time of entry.

All Horses/Ponies must be registered with Equestrian Australia and resident in Qld (and within a 100km radius of the border) for a total period of 3 months & 1 day immediately preceding the date of the HOTY Event. *Horses competing in Newcomer classes must be registered with EA and owner or part owner and horses registered address must be in Qld and must be registered at time of close of entries.*

All horses must have a Full Life Registration with EA, must carry and present a current height certificate for any classes in which they are nominating in at each show.

2. Contact with Appointed Judge/s

If it is brought to the attention of the organising committee that any owner/rider/exhibitor/lessee has been in contact with and/or makes contact with an appointed judge at any stage throughout the duration of the show, that owner/rider/exhibitor/lessee will automatically forfeit their right to entry.

3. Protests

All protests must be submitted in writing to the ringmaster no later than sixty (60) minutes following the completion of the class in question. All protests shall be accompanied by a cash fee of \$200.00 which shall be forfeited should the protest be deemed frivolous.

4. Payments - Payments are NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE.

5. Prize/s - Any prize/s not collected on the day of the show will be forfeited.

6. Newcomer HOTY (in addition to the above rules) – Must have a current Height certificate

- a. Newcomer HOTY is open to horses and ponies which have NOT competed in any under saddle class at any event (excluding racing), which includes but is not limited to – breed, local, pony club, dressage, jumping etc. prior to 1st July 2022. *A Pony that has only competed in Leading Rein or Miniature Turnouts and has not competed off the lead is eligible to be considered a Newcomer. (As per the National Show Horse rules)*
- b. Horses and ponies which have competed under saddle in any event in any state (excluding racing) prior to 1st July 2022 are not eligible to compete.
- c. All horses and ponies are to be ridden in a simple snaffle bridle. Nosebands may be cavesson, Hanoverian or drop, as per EA rules.
- d. Horses and ponies must be 3yrs of age or over at 1 August in the competing year
- e. All owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees must be current financial members at the time of entry.
- f. Any Newcomer must have started at it's first show in QLD, to be eligible for EQ Newcomer classes
- g. All riders must hold competitor level membership
- h. Owners at a minimum, must hold supporter level membership
- i. All horses must have a full Life Registration with EA at the time of close of entries.
- j. Newcomer season is from 1 July 2022 – 30 June 2023

7. **Intermediate HOTY** (in addition to the above rules)
- a. Intermediate HOTY is open to horses and ponies which have **NOT** or won or runner-up at any EA State HOTY (including Intermediate and open HOTY), or won 1st or 2nd in any open hack or open show hunter class at any Royal Show.
 - b. Horses and ponies must be owned/leased in Queensland
 - c. All riders and exhibitors must be bone fide residents of Queensland at time of entries
 - d. All Horses/Ponies must be 3 years of age or over at 1 August in the competing year
 - e. Riders Membership must be competitor
 - f. Owners at a minimum, must hold supporter level membership
 - g. Horses and ponies must be registered with Equestrian Queensland and resident in Queensland for at least three months & one day prior to the date of this show.
8. All Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration forms must be submitted to the show secretary on the day of the show, prior to the commencement of classes.
9. All Horses must be Gear Checked before entry into the ring by a Gear Steward.
10. Helmets must be in accordance with the Equestrian Australia General Regulation - Article 122.
11. Lead Rein riders – turning 5 years – the age of 5 commences from the child’s birthday. The Under 8 age limit is taken as per the child’s age as at 1 January in the calendar year that the competition is being held. The handler must be 18 years of age and over.

All National Qualifying classes will be run in accordance with EA National ShowHorse Rules effective 1st January 2023

1. Rules

It is the responsibility of all owners and riders and exhibitors and lessees to be familiar with and aware of all National Show Horse Rules and the Equestrian Australia rules which govern this sport. For example; the constitution, by-law and policies consist of, but are not limited to: Codes of Conduct, Equine Anti-Doping and Medication Control Regulations. Please refer to the Member Protection Policy, link listed below.

2. Contact with Appointed Judge/s

If it is brought to the attention of the organizing committee that any person / competitor / rider / owner / lessee has been in contact with and/or makes contact with an appointed judge at any stage throughout the duration of the show, that competitor / rider / owner / lessee / mount will automatically forfeit their right to entry.

No Competitor/Spectator shall enter the judges/officials shade tent, or you will automatically forfeit your placing.

3. Protests

All protests must be submitted in writing to the ringmaster no later than sixty (60) minutes following the completion of the class in question. All protests shall be accompanied by a cash fee of \$200.00 which shall be forfeited should the protest be deemed frivolous.

4. Payments

Payments are NON-REFUNDABLE at closure date and NON-TRANSFERABLE (Transferable entry money may be considered with a vet certificate).

5. Prizes

Any prizes not collected on the day of the show will be forfeited.

6. All Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration forms must be submitted to the show secretary on the day of the show, prior to the commencement of classes. For health declaration follow link on website link: <https://www.qld.equestrian.org.au/member-resources/biosecurity>

7. Members/owners/lessees and their life registered horses will be required to qualify if entering Show Horse Queensland HOTY including Child's classes.

8. Members/owners/lessees and their life registered horses will be required to participate at one (1) qualifying shows. Show Horse Queensland reserves the right to reduce the qualifications required, giving consideration to the number of qualification events provided to members during the course of the year and other situations that may occur including the current uncertainty with Covid 19.

9. Highest Scoring Owner Rider

To be eligible to compete for the **Highest Scoring Owner Rider** - you must be a financial member of Equestrian Queensland and you must have registered and paid the fee for you and nominated horse for the 2023 year as an Owner Rider prior to this show.

10. All child riders must be under 18 years of age as at the 1st January 2023.

11. Heights are under EA guidelines for all sections.

12. Newcomer, Intermediate, Child Classes & Rider Classes will have a set workout.

13. Music is to be supplied per class for the HOTY Child's Classes (but is optional not a requirement). Further information will be advised.

14. All Horses must be Gear Checked by a Gear Check Steward before entering the ring.

15. Ring Stewarding area behind the main ring for the class – only horses competing in the current class with the nominated rider are allowed in this area.

16. Only Horses competing in the class will allowed be in the marshalling area with the nominated rider.

17. All dogs must be on a lead and not on horse arena / warm up area
