- Equestrian Queensland Member's \$5.00 each class
- **NON Equestrian Queensland Members** may participate on payment of a **Restricted Event Membership Fee** (\$35.00) upon signing of a Restricted Membership Form which includes a Liability Waiver Form (attached) – Restricted members please note that there is no personal accident coverage in this restricted membership fee. Classes for restricted members are \$9.00 per class
- All necessary forms are attached – **please complete forms prior to arrival** to save queuing times.

1. A horse that wins champion open in a particular class may not enter the same class in another ring. Reserve Champions **may** compete in another ring.
2. Youth/Childs must be 17 years and under (as at the 1st January 2019).
3. To be eligible to compete in Owner Rider classes, you must be a financial Equestrian Queensland Show Horse Owner Rider member, and the horse **must** Not to have been ridden by anyone other than the owner"

Proof of membership and horse registration certificate may be required. Prizes will be

4. All newcomer horses must not have competed under saddle before the 1st of July 2019 and a Statutory Declaration declaring they have not must be presented if necessary. All Newcomers must have competed at their first show in QLD to be eligible for Newcomer classes.
5. Horses are required to be registered with Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch), for this show.
7. Rings cannot be held up if classes clash. The Committee will do their best to accommodate your class entries.
8. It is the responsibility of all riders/owners/lessee/competitors to be familiar with and aware of all Equestrian Australia rules which govern this sport. For example; the constitution, by-law and policies consist of, but are not limited to: Codes of Conduct, Equine Anti-Doping and Medication Control Regulations. Please refer to the Member Protection Policy, link listed below.

9. Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Membership cards **MUST** be presented to purchase tickets and ride otherwise you will need to pay the Restricted Membership fees and the higher entry fees.
10. All RIDERS must wear protective headgear to the current Australian Standard. The retaining chin straps must be fastened at all times.
11. For safety reasons, ALL RIDERS must wear suitable riding boots that are heeled and soled, with little or no tread, at all times when riding at EA events.
12. All protests must be submitted in writing to the ringmaster no later than sixty (60) minutes following the completion of the event in question. All protests shall be accompanied by a cash fee of \$150.00 which shall be forfeited should the protest be deemed frivolous.
13. **Payments** - Payments are NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE.
14. **Prize/s** - Any prize/s not collected on the day of the show will be forfeited.
15. **Contact with Appointed Judge/s**
If it is brought to the attention of the organizing committee that any competitor/rider/owner/lessee has been in contact with and/or makes contact with an appointed judge at any stage throughout the duration of the show, that competitor/rider/owner/lessee will automatically forfeit their right to entry.
16. No Competitor/Spectator shall enter the judges/officials shade tent or you will be automatically forfeit your placing.
17. Leader Board Points-Owner/Rider Horse/Rider combination cannot have mixture of points for hunter and open. Once start in Open or Hunter must accumulate points for the high points in the Open or Hunter classes only.
18. Rules pertaining to the restricted membership- Only 1 can be used per calendar year.
19. It is the decision of the E Q Show Horse committee to select the final team for Qld to be sent to the **2020 NSW SOUTHERN CROSS HORSE SPECTACULAR- all winners, champion, res-champion third place getters will be considered.**

Amateur Owner/Home Produced Application Form 2019

This form is not a membership application for the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. To be eligible to apply for Amateur Owner/Home Produced status, you must be a financial member of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. This Amateur Owner/Home Produced application must be accompanied with a copy of your current Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) membership card, horse(s) Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) registration and height certificate, a Statutory Declaration stating that the applicant meets the requirements to be considered eligible for Amateur Owner/Home Produced status in accordance with the Equestrian Queensland Show Horse guidelines regarding Amateur Owner/Home Produced requirements and guidelines. To be eligible to compete in Amateur Owner/Home Produced events, you must be registered with Equestrian Queensland Show Horse as an Amateur Owner/Home Produced Rider. Payment is non-refundable and non-transferable. If for any reason the processing of your payment is unsuccessful then your application will not be accepted.

Amateur Owner/Home Produced Rules

A person is an amateur for the purposes of classes run under Equestrian Queensland amateur owner/ home produced rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous year:

1. Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.
2. Received remuneration or sponsorship in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school. (Instruction at Pony club and Riding club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
3. Own/part own an Equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner/ part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.
4. Show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, in any showing classes.
5. A competitor is not eligible to compete in amateur classes on an Exhibit which has been ridden by a Professional rider in any open classes during the current year unless the Horse has subsequently been re-registered under new Ownership. (The only exception will be child's classes).
6. Rider must be current member of the State Branch of Equestrian Australia. A minimum of participant level membership is required. A child may retain amateur status if he/she rides a horse/pony for another person but only in designated child's classes. The child will not be considered an amateur if he/she exhibits a horse on behalf of another owner/s.
7. The horse/pony registration lodged with Equestrian Australia must reflect the name of the amateur owner rider as owner or part owner. Any other part owners must be immediate family. Leased horses are eligible as long as the amateur owner is reflected as the lessee on the EA horse registration of that horse and lease must be for a minimum of 12 months duration. Horse/pony must be registered with any other society in the same name/s as EA registration and must be produced upon request for inspection.
8. The horse/pony must be primarily ridden and trained by the rider/owner with only periodic ridden assistance by person/s other than the owner. Specifically the horse/pony must not have been ridden or trained by anyone, other than the owner for a period of 3 months immediately preceding the day of competition for any event in which the rider wishes to compete as an amateur owner rider.
9. Open to horses which are either stabled at home or in a D.I.Y yard and has not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard.
10. This section refers to riding classes and saddle classes, for the avoidance of doubt, led classes are not included in any way within these rules.
11. Judges for these classes are to apply a 50:50 rule in relation to conformation and work. It is the intention of these classes to encourage competitors to focus on education and work as well as being judged on the horses conformation. These classes are levelled at grass roots competition with a focus on competitors being judged on the basics of good riding and work, not just the best conformed horse. We ask that all judges in these classes apply this formula when judging.

No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/ strip the Horse
Any protests regarding eligibility must be lodged in writing on the day of the event with \$150.

To be eligible to apply for Owner Rider status, you must be a financial member of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. This Owner Rider application must be accompanied with a copy of your current Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) membership card, horse(s) Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) registration and height certificate, a Statutory Declaration stating that the applicant meets the requirements to be considered eligible for Owner Rider status in accordance with the Equestrian Queensland Show Horse guidelines regarding Owner Rider requirements and guidelines and a fee of \$35. To be eligible to compete in Owner Rider events, you must be registered with Equestrian Queensland Show Horse as an Owner Rider. Payment is non-refundable and non-transferable. If for any reason the processing of your payment is unsuccessful then your application will not be accepted.

Owner Rider Rules and Regulations:

1. All riders/owners/leases, entered or competing in the ridden Equestrian Queensland Show must be financial members of the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. and all horses entered or competing in the ridden Equestrian Queensland Show must be registered with the Equestrian Australia (Queensland Branch) Inc. Such membership/registrations shall be effective by close of entries.
2. All horses and ponies to have an official EA/EQ lease or be the bona fide property of the rider. An official lease must have been in existence for a period of at least three months prior to the show for the owner-rider classes.
3. Horses and ponies must not have been ridden, trained or exhibited under saddle by any other person in the previous three months. Horses and Ponies must not have been ridden by anyone other than the owner. The only exception being those horses and ponies which have been ridden by another person who is also a registered owner-rider (subject to rule 2)

Owner Riders will be required to complete a declaration and acknowledgement to prove eligibility and submit this with their Owner Rider application form.

Any protests regarding eligibility must be lodged in writing on the day of the event with \$150.
