



Emma Ireland has competed in New Zealand and Dubai and at only 18 years has big dreams of one day competing for Australia in the World Endurance Championships. Emma's achievements include winning the Junior and Best Conditioned at the 2019 Tom Quilty in the biggest junior field in history. Placing 1st-5th place in every Tom Quilty that she has ever entered. Riding Bullio Winter and placing 2nd in the FEI 120km 2*. Riding Matar Stables placing 2nd in the 120km Junior with an average speed of 16.83kms per hour.

SHELLEY CHAPMAN TEAM AUSTRALIA RESERVE ATHLETE

Shelley is extremely passionate about the sport and equine athletes, having competed in endurance for over 30 years & achieved 22,866 km in that time. She is humbled to have achieved the highest documented distance and points rider in 2023 with 2792 km and 199 points, 8 from 8 Quilty Buckles and riding Box Hill Nitro won the Lightweight at the 2022 Queensland State Championships. Box Hill Nitro and Shelly also won the Lightweight at Good Boy Treasure on 1 November 2023 along with 4 other first placings in 2023. Box Hill Nitro received Queensland's 1st Lightweight Points Horse with 40.50 and 2nd Lightweight Distance with 806 km.















Each race completed is not just a competition but a testament to her love for horses, the sport, and the thrill of pushing her limits to achieve greatness in every ride.




