

Sunday includes qualifying classes for the 20th International Welsh Show, Australia, 2019.










PLEASE NOTE DIRECTIONS & PARKING FOR HORSE FLOATS & TRUCKS
All horse exhibitors will need to enter the grounds via Greentrees Avenue, onto Rafting Ground Road & then
back onto Brookfield Road to the parking entrance.



NOMINATIONS CAN BE MADE IN RING CENTRE FROM 7:00am.

Entries on the day - entry fees to be paid before judging commences.

By lodging your nomination on the day you accept the rules, by laws and regulations of the Show Society.

NO SPECTATORS, CHILDREN, STROLLERS, OR DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE MAIN ARENA THROUGHOUT THE SHOW. THIS IS A WORKPLACE HEALTH & SAFETY REQUIREMENT.

A qualified Ambulance Bearer from Emergency First Aid Services will be located in ring centre and a van beside the Secretary's Office will be equipped with full emergency gear.

BIOSECURITY RULES

- The Brookfield Show Society strongly recommends that all horse are currently vaccinated against Hendra virus.
- All people bringing livestock onto event grounds are expected to be aware of their biosecurity obligation which is that they must take all reasonable steps to ensure activities do not spread pests, disease or contaminants.

They are advised that:

- No animals with signs of illness are to be brought onto the grounds
- They are responsible for cleaning up manure and placing in designated areas
- Competitors are required to advise Event Organisers immediately of sick animals, and they are to stop all non-essential contact with sick animals, ensuring that children do not have close contact.
- Everyone handling animals should wash or sanitise hands between contact with other animals.
- Horse Health Declarations (HHD) are a mandatory requirement for all Horse exhibitors.
- Property Identification Codes (PICs) of origin and destination must be on HHDs.
- Acceptance into the event will be refused if an HHD is not presented at designated registration point.
- No communal horse water troughs will be available at the event. Equipment, including food and water containers are not to be shared between horses.
- Any person in charge of a horse or horses, whether competing or not, must, on entering the Showground, complete and present a Horse Health Declaration (HHD) for each horse at <u>a</u> <u>designated registration point</u>. The Property Identification Code (PIC) for the Brookfield Showground (550 Brookfield Road Brookfield) and Cemetery Paddock (46 Boscombe Road Brookfield) is QJBB0368.
- Each competitor, when nominating for events, must hand to the Nominations Steward a signed HHD for each horse and a signed QCAS waiver form, at the nomination desk in ring centre.
- All horses at the Brookfield Show must be tick free.

All riders enter these events at their own risk. Neither the organising committee, nor the Brookfield Show Society accepts any responsibility for injury to any person, horse or property howsoever caused.

E.A. rules apply in all Hacking and Showjumping events.

Horses entered in any class to be measured at the discretion of the stewards.

Horses entered in any class may be swabbed at the discretion of the stewards. EA RULES WILL APPLY.

The Ring Committee reserves the right to change the sequence of events at its discretion.

Competitors are expected to check the rings and be on time for their respective classes.

An exhibitor shall ensure that horse and competitor are entered and shown only in the correct classes. Penalties will be incurred at the Society's discretion should this rule be violated.

The judge's decision shall be final. No competitor or exhibitor shall approach a judge with regard to a decision unless they first obtain permission from the Chief' Steward or Ring Steward.

Bookings will include a \$30 deposit per stable or yard, which will be refunded when keys and locks are returned TO RING CENTRE.

Keys and padlocks for confirmed bookings will be in a box at the Cricketers Pavilion for collection.

Keys and padlocks can be returned at any time when nominations are open.

When vacating stable please leave CLEAN, UNLOCKED, and return padlocks and keys so that deposits can be refunded.

Please return key and locks to ring centre prior to 2pm latest.

Cash has to be requested from a Stable Steward in Ring Centre. If deposit is a cheque we will destroy it.

District classes are open to **owners, horses and riders** who are all resident in the Kenmore, Brookfield, Upper Brookfield, Anstead, Bellbowrie, Chapel Hill, Indooroopilly, Taringa, Corinda, Chelmer, Graceville, Karana Downs, Moggill, Pinjarra Hills, Pullenvale, Fig Tree Pocket, Jindalee/Centenary suburbs and The Gap districts and all financial members of Brookfield, Moggill, Yarrawa & Corinda Pony Clubs. **NOTE: Proof of residency may be asked for in District Classes.**

Because District Events are restricted events, awards won do not affect eligibility for the rest of the Show. However, they will restrict competition in district events in future years.

Novice: Novice Hack is one that has not won an Open or District Championship as a hack at a provincial show.

Top boots may not be worn by riders under 17 years in Rider classes.

E.A. Approved Safety Helmets are compulsory for riders under 17 years.
