Conditions of Entry

- This event will be held in accordance with Equestrian Australia rules (as amended). Neither the organising committee of any competition to which these rules apply, nor the EA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, and spectators or any person or property whatsoever. By entering this competition, riders agree to abide by EA rules and codes of conduct.
- 2. Horse Health Declaration **must** be submitted to **gear check** upon arrival at the grounds. Please do not wait until presenting at gear check for your test. No signed and completed Declaration will mean Elimination.
- 3. Nominations must be accompanied by a signed EA Waiver to be accepted
- 4. No refunds for scratching's after closing date unless accompanied by a certificate/notification from a recognised equine practitioner or recognised medical practitioner within 3 days of the event.
- 5. If scratching's do occur within these provisions, the club will retain 20% for administration fees.
- 6. This event is run by volunteers, mainly riders for riders. We ask that all participants share half to 1 hour to help out. A volunteer's roster will be done up, if it clashes with your other plans please let the committee know ASAP. if you can't help yourself but can nominate someone else, please let the committee know this person's name.
- 7. Each horse may only compete in a maximum of 3 tests at 2 consecutive levels.
- 8. Each rider may only enter a maximum of 3 horses.
- 9. ALL stallion owners must abide by the EA Stallion Safe Practice Policy effective 14 July 2018.
- 10. The club reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any section of the programme or to limit the number of entries if nominations are excessive or undersubscribed. The club reserves the right to accept or reject entries.
- 11. Only callers are allowed between the 2 arenas and forward of the judges. All spectators, including photographers and videographers, are not allowed within 10 metres of the arenas. This is not our rule but an Equestrian Australia rule.
- 12. There is no prizemoney however ribbons will be given to 6^{th} place.
- 13. Swabbing may occur at any event conducted by this club.
- 14. Ground Levy fee is made up of \$10.00 ground levy fee (payable to GCEG for arena and grounds maintenance) and \$2.00 water levy payable to the Mount Larcom Show Society.
- 15. Junior riders are eligible for junior classes and awarded separately to open classes.

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Camping and Stabling

The GCEG collects the camping and stabling fees on behalf of the Mount Larcom Show Society. We do not make any money on top of these fees.

Camping: Camping is charged at \$20.00 per night for up to 2 people, then \$5.00 per person thereafter. This is for each camp site. Anyone plugged in to the power boxes that are installed around the venue must pay this fee (even if you don't stay overnight).

Stabling: Stables are charged at \$10.00 per stable per day.

Stables must be left in a clean state with manure etc. taken to designated areas. If stables are left dirty, the Show Society charges us \$50.00 per stall to clean them. This fee will have to be passed on to the stable user. Alternatively if you arrive and the stables are not cleaned appropriately, please take photos and advise one of the committee members so we can inform the show society.
