




getting 'grant ready'

- Certificate of incorporation / registration
- Constitution or governing document
- Audited financial statements
- Lease or other tenure (if applicable)
- Your strategic plan / business plan / risk management plan
- Relevant governing body or government plans and strategies
- Register of members / customer database
- Quotes, plans, designs and approvals


- Engage emotionally
- Assume a reading age of 13 years
- Write like a news article first things first

tips for success

- Stick to word limits
- Use short sentences and dot-points
- Be precise
- DNU jargon, acronyms or specific terminology
- Answer every question fully never leave a blank
- Replicate wording from the guidelines and application questions
- Support answers with research and documentation
- Unless prohibited, include (relevant) appendices and clearly link to these in your answers
- Start writing early!

finalisation and submission

- Ensure file size suitability and collate appendices if possible
- Review and proof reed don't rely on spell cheque...
- Submit prior to the due date
- Follow submission instructions in the guidelines
- Obtain a lodgement receipt
