



Guidelines for running COUNTRY JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS QUEENSLAND

The applicant is to submit their final program, stating heights of classes, Course Designer & Judge when submitting the application to jumpingqldsecretary@equestrianqld.com.au by Friday 21 October 2022.

The host committee will be expected to agree to run the Championships under Jumping Queensland's terms and conditions.

Country Championships –

Jumping Queensland will supply

Embroidered cotton rugs for winners of Championship Classes will be supplied by Jumping Queensland.

The successful Host Committee can apply for funding through the Equestrian Queensland Sport Development Competition & Event Funding. Funding Criteria and Application process together with the deliverables required, can be found on the link provided [HERE](#)

Jumping Queensland is to be supplied with the proposed officials prior to the approval of the program/schedule.

Host Committee to supply

Warm up class and championship classes for the following (as a minimum)

Queensland State Country Children Championship (14yrs and under) (height 1.05m)

Queensland State Country Junior Championship (height 1.20m)

Queensland State Country Young Rider Championship (height 1.30m)

Queensland State Country Amateur Rider Championship (height 1.15m)

Queensland State Country Championship for horses under 16 points (height 1.10m)

Queensland State Country Championship for horses under 40 points (height 1.30m)

Queensland State Country Senior Championship (height 1.50m)

At each of these events each HORSE is only eligible to compete in ONE Championship.

This rule does not apply to any speed championship that is run in conjunction with these events.

Host Committee will be required to take pre-nominations on a platform to be decided.

The organising Committee reserves the right to change this program at any time.

All placegetters MUST present for prizes mounted, or prizemoney is forfeited

Competitors compete at their own risk. All riders must wear helmets that comply with EA Helmet standards.

Horses may only enter in **maximum of 2 classes per day and only 1 Championship Class**

A horse/rider combination may enter only one part of a combined class.

Classes 7, 8 & 9 will be run in conjunction – **one** class per horse

Where there are less than 10 entries in any class, the organising committee reserves the right to combine or cancel the class.

The organising committee reserves the right to change prizes/prizemoney

All riders competing at the event will be expected to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry, and must sign a waiver form in the office before competing.

GUIDELINES FOR EVENTS

Article 255 – Amateur Riders

1. Amateur Rider classes are classes for Athletes who:

- Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing
- In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round.
- Must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.

1.1 Athletes must meet the membership requirements as set out in the EA General Regulations.

1.2 Athletes may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age.

1.3 Organisers may at their discretion limit the number of horses a rider can start.

1.4 The course shall be free-flowing and relatively simple. The first obstacle in the first round should be 10cm lower than the advertised starting height of the competition.

1.5 There will be a maximum height rise of 10cm for the jump-off.
