

Guidelines for running COUNTRY JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS QUEENSLAND

The applicant is to submit their final program, stating heights of classes, Course Designer & Judge when submitting the application to <u>jumpingqldsecretary@equestrianqld.com.au</u> by Friday 12 January, 2024.

The host committee will be expected to agree to run the Championships under Jumping Queensland's terms and conditions.

Country Championships -

Jumping Queensland will supply embroidered cotton rugs for winners of each Championship Class.

The successful Host Committee can apply for funding through the Equestrian Queensland Sport Development Competition & Event Funding. Funding Criteria and Application process together with the deliverables required, can be found on the link provided <u>HERE</u>

Jumping Queensland is to be supplied with the proposed officials prior to the approval of the program/schedule.

Host Committee will be required to take pre-nominations on a platform to be decided.

Host Committee to supply

Warm up class and championship classes for the following (as a minimum)

Queensland State Country Children Championship (14yrs and under) (height 1.05m) Queensland State Country Junior Championship (height 1.20m) Queensland State Country Young Rider Championship (height 1.30m) Queensland State Country Amateur Rider Championship (height 1.15m) Queensland State Country Novice Championship (height 1.10m) for horses that have not competed above 1.20m in the previous 6 months Queensland State Country Intermediate Championship (height 1.30m) for horses that have not competed above 1.40m and above in the previous 6 months Queensland State Country Senior Championship (height 1.40m)

At each of these events each HORSE is only eligible to compete in ONE Championship. This rule does not apply to any speed championship that is run in conjunction with these events.
