



#### **Bridle Numbers**

All horses competing in the World Cup class have been allocated a bridle number. Bridle numbers MUST be displayed on both sides of either the bridle or saddle cloth when competing or under saddle, and on either the bridle or headstall at any time they are outside of their stables. It is the responsibility of the rider to provide their own bridle numbers and holders to display the allocated number.

#### FEI - health monitoring

It is an FEI requirement that you have taken your horse's temperature 3 days prior to your arrival at the event and logged in the FEI HorseApp. Ensure you have completed your horse's Self-Certification Form.

#### **Arrivals**

World Cup horses must be present on the grounds by **midday Friday 12th July**, and will be checked in by FEI Steward. Arrival inspections will take place **12.00-1.00pm on Friday 12th July**. The vet and steward will come to your stable. Please have your horse's passport, thermometer, a handler and horse ready.

#### **Stabling**

World Cup horses will be allocated stabling within the FEI designated area. Armbands for FEI riders and their groom/s and horse owner/s (max 5) will be supplied on arrival. Armbands will will checked upon entry to FEI stabling.

#### Horse Inspection (Trot Up)

Trot up will take place at **8.00am Saturday 13th July** at the QSEC Stable Complex. Please be on time and ready with bridle numbers and passport. Stallions first please and then in bridle number order where possible.

- All nominations to be made via Equipe: General Entries will open at 7.00pm Monday 10th June
- Early Entries the Equipe entry system will open be open for our sponsors, world cup riders and our committee.

  If you have note been invited to do so, entries placed before General Entries opening date will be DELETED
- Nominations close: 7.00pm Monday 1st July, if classes not full earlier.
- Entries will only be accepted once your payment has been processed
- Number of Starts: Ring 1: one start per horse/day with exception of Classes 3 & 23. Max. two starts per horse/day over all rings. In the case of excessive entries, the OC may reduce number of starts to one per horse/day if required.
- Per rider in a class No rider will be permitted more than three (3) entries in any one class.
- Wait lists will be created for classes if over-subscribed, competitors will be notified of acceptance once nominations are finalised.
- Equestrian Australia Waivers must be signed and Horse Health Declarations must be completed prior to arrival. Prize money will be withheld if form not supplied. Links to online JotForms are on Equipe.
- Junior riders cannot compete in Juniors and Young Rider on the same horse.
- Presentation riders must present to award ceremonies mounted (stallions may be substituted for presentation)
- Draws will be posted on EQUIPE by 6pm each evening before competition. Rings 1 and 2 will take precedence.

- Horses may <u>not</u> start in both World Cup and Mini Prix Class
- Young Horse classes: age of horse on day of competition. One Start only for Classes 13,14,15. FEI Young Horse boot rule applies.
- David Overton Memorial Cup: Horses aged 6,7,8 years per EA Article 275 Future Stars. FEI Young Horse boot rule applies.
- First Aid Levy \$10 per rider / day
- Ground Fee \$10 per horse / show
- Admin/Scoring Fee \$10 per horse / show
- Changes: each change to nominations after the close of entries will attract a \$5 administration fee.
- Any changes must be made by 4.00pm the day prior to class. Changes must be made at the event office.

#### **Tour Rules**

- Emerald Tour: Height will start 1.15m, Final 1.20m. Horses he Emerald Tour cannot compete in any class higher than 1.25m at this event.
- Amateur Tour: Starting height 1.15m, with Final first round at 1.20m. Regulations per EA rules.
- Junior Tour starting height 1.15m and Childrens Tours starting height 1.00m: Regulations per EA rules
- Horse/rider combination must compete in **at least one** Tour Round to be eligible for the final.
- A horse may only compete in ONE Tour Final
- Tour Final draws will be seeded per leaderboard for each tour

**TSHA Classes Eligibility:** Horses must obtain a TSHA competition license to enter these classes. License is available on Global Entries Online (Manage Horses). Only horses with Thoroughbred Stud Book registration will be accepted. No part bred Thoroughbreds. For full details including how to obtain a license, visit: www.thoroughbredsporthorse.com.au

Magic Millions Qualifier: Riders must be 16 years or older, one horse per rider, horse must not have competed above 1.20m in 12 months prior to 5/1/2025, Rider must be employed directly or indirectly within the Australian thoroughred racing industry.
